

Activity Maps

If you print Activity Maps from FPARS - please follow these standards:

- Use black ink
 - Do not use white-out
 - Do not use color pencils or highlighters
 - Include a copy of your legend
 - Do not enlarge or reduce these maps
 - Do not write in the margins
 - Use more than one map if you need to
 - Do not fax these maps to DNR
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If you are substituting your GIS map for a DNR Activity Map from FPARS, your map must meet these standards:

Labels For Units: You must use Numbers and not Names or Symbols

Features:

- Current DNR water and wetland layers
- DNR Geographic registration TIC marks using NAD83
- Contour lines (maximum 40' interval)
- Section, township and range lines and numbers
- Section or ¼ section corners
- Scale bar
- North arrow
- Legend

Margins: ¼" on all sides

Scale Range: From 1" = 200' to 1" = 1,000'

Size Range: From Letter to Tabloid

Lettering: Black ink is preferred. Do not use yellow.

Shading: Do not use yellow or red
