2024-2025 SEEDLING PRE-ORDER

The DNR-managed Webster Forest Nursery grows a variety of native conifer seedlings for different planting zones in Washington state. Webster Nursery sells seedlings to help small private land owners meet replanting requirements.



Pre-order requests are accepted through September 13, 2024. Seedlings are not first-come, first-served during the pre-order window. To serve a greater number of Washington landowners, Webster Nursery fills as many pre-order requests as possible.

If the nursery cannot fulfill your large pre-order request, you will have priority to purchase available seedlings if other orders are cancelled. We maintain records of unfilled pre-order requests and will reach out to you periodically with updates.

In October 2024, Webster Nursery will confirm order details and invoice customers. Payment is due within 30 days to secure the order. Pick-ups may be scheduled December 2024-May 2025.

DNR Webster Nursery does not guarantee survivability of plants after they leave our care, either when the buyer picks them up or after we ship the seedlings to the buyer's destination.

<u>PAYMENT:</u> Pre-payment in full is required to secure an order. Upon receiving their invoice, customers have 30 days to complete payment. Orders are subject to cancellation without notice if not paid in full. Webster Nursery accepts only cash or check payments. **We are unable to accept credit cards.**

Seedling Distribution Information

At Webster Nursery, we give seedlings the best possible care during their growing season, cull them for quality, and package them appropriately for cool storage conditions. The way you handle these seedlings is important in making your tree-planting project a success.

Plan ahead to plant your seedlings. If you can't plant your seedlings within one or two days, we suggest you refrigerate them at 33°F (ideal) to 36°F (maximum) to prevent respiration and mold damage. If you have a large order and inadequate storage, consider staggering your pick-up dates or shipments.

by 12" by 12" and weigh up to 40 pounds. Boxes measure approximately 36" by 11" by 9" and weigh up to 40 pounds. Ensure you have adequate transportation to pick up your order. The best seedling transportation is in a covered, cool vehicle protected from sun and wind.

If someone else will pick up seedlings on your behalf, you must notify the nursery to release to the appropriate party.

UPS shipments typically arrive at addresses in Washington state 1-2 days after leaving the nursery. Nursery liability ceases when seedlings are delivered to carrier.
