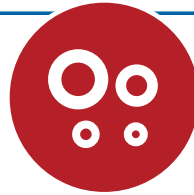


The State of STDs in Texas



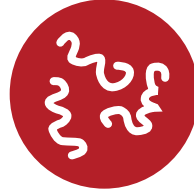
STD RATES ON THE RISE ACROSS THE STATE

267% increase since 2011

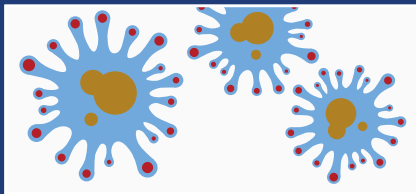

- ▶ Pregnant women

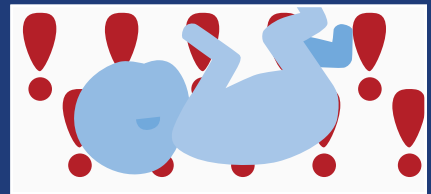
LEFT UNTREATED, STDS CAN CAUSE:
