Thank you for taking the time to speak with me today about the above-referenced advisory opinion request. I've summarized the information you provided on the phone. Please respond by email to confirm that the information below is correct or to correct any errors.

- GTSG will automatically transmit the tally of contributions made from each phone number to the political committees.
- The \$50 aggregate limit on contributions a single contributor will be per calendar year.
- GTSG will transmit the funds to the political committees within 7 days.
- If a contributor responds "no" or fails to reply to either text message from GTSG (confirming intent and eligibility to make the contribution), GTSG will not process the contribution. If the contributor replies "no" to the first text message, he or she will not receive the second text message.
- The credit card processor will not have the cardholder's name and address.
