In September 2024, the American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network (ACS CAN) will host its 14th annual Lights of Hope event.

When the sun goes down on September 17, the pond at Constitution Gardens will be surrounded with cancerfighting advocates sending messages to the leaders of our country that we need more funding for cancer research and prevention, that we need to focus on the quality of life of patients and their families, that we need to put an end to this disease as we know it.

The pond will also be glowing with approximately 10,000 Lights of Hope bags dedicated to loved ones who have been touched by cancer. In addition to the 70,000 bags that will be lit across the country. Each Light of Hope honors loved ones who have survived cancer and remembers those we've lost.
