Nancy,

I am sorry to send these so late, I read everything on the flight Monday but forget to then send you an email.

First, thank you for the great work on this. It is encouraging to see the state's expanding efforts to serve Floridians with the greatest need. I had a few questions/comments, my apologies for the brevity. Most of these are likely more related to implementation than the actual plan being submitted. I actually stated my vacation this morning and want to get started with it...

- I would require a high percentage of the funded units be 1-bedroom; in the communities we serve the greatest need among households relying upon SSI income is for 1-bedroom units
- When the plan references considering the extent to which the proposed development has rental assistance, is
  this intended to focus on projects without that assistance? As you know, I do not believe units with this
  assistance require additional subsidy to serve ELI and SSI reliant households
  - Why are acquisition/rehab projects not eligible? I don't understand why an acq/rehab project cannot serve
    these households. Couldn't acq/rehabs with fully accessible units serve these households
  - On pages 12 and 22 I think you want to remove the "<" before 100,000 in the range</li>
  - On pages 18 and 21 don't you mean 66 units, not 16
  - Page 23 in number 3, I think you mean managers at NHTF-funded properties
