1 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: By the vested in me
2 by the State of Illinois and the Illinois Commerce
3 Commission, I now call for status hearing Docket
4 No. 74 RTV-R Sub 15 for status hearing. This is in
5 the matter of Rendered Services, Inc., and the issue
6 presented is its application for renewal of
7 commercial relocators license.

8 May I have appearances, please. Let's
9 start with the Commerce Commission Staff.

10 MS. ANDERSON: Thank you, your Honor.

11 My name is Jennifer Anderson. I
12 appear on behalf of the Staff of the Illinois
13 Commerce Commission. My address is 160 North LaSalle
14 Street, Chicago, Illinois 60601. My phone number is
15 312-814-1934.

16 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: Okay.

17 MR. BARR: Good morning. My name is Benjamin
18 Barr. I also appear on behalf of the Staff of the
19 Illinois Commerce Commission. My address is
20 160 North LaSalle Street, Suite 800, Chicago,
21 Illinois 60601. And my phone number is 312-814-2859.

22 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: All right. Rendered?

1 MR. ROTHSCHILD: Good morning. My name is
2 Donald S. Rothschild. My business address is
3 835 McClintock Drive, Burr Ridge, Illinois 60527.
4 I'm an attorney licensed by the Supreme Court, and I
5 represent the respondent, Rendered Services, Inc.

6 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: Okay. Thank you.

7 When we last met in April, we set a
8 schedule for responding to data request. And Staff
9 is supposed to have its discovery propounded to
10 Rendered by May 4th. And Rendered had agreed to
11 propound its discovery to the Commission by May 24
12 and that's the purpose of today's status hearing, to
13 discuss whether those priorities have been met.

14 So why don't you start, Ms. Anderson,
15 and let me know where things stand.

16 MS. ANDERSON: Thank you, your Honor.

17 Rendered Services didn't propound
18 requests on Staff for documents as well as
19 interrogatories. I have received those over the past
20 couple of weeks. There's a period that I was on
21 vacation, and I have some other colleagues that I
22 need to work with in order to respond to these

1 requests who have also been on vacation throughout
2 this period.

3 So our progress to this point has been
4 minimal particularly with regard to the requests for
5 documents. There are certain requests that would
6 involve potentially producing a significant number of
7 material. And because I haven't been able to have
8 conversations yet with all necessary people who would
9 be able to locate responsive documents.

10 At this point it's difficult to say
11 how long production would take, but we are already
12 engaged in efforts to try to respond to the requests,
13 and I would ask for another discovery on status
14 30 days from now.

15 MR. ROTHSCHILD: Your Honor, we received
16 Ms. Anderson's data requests and are in the midst of
17 working on them. We're probably about halfway done.
18 I have some of this stuff to show you I've been to go
19 something.

20 And I agree that we need a status on
21 discovery date because I think most of the requests
22 we intend to respond to without any controversy or

1 issue. There are a few issues that we're trying to
2 work around, and perhaps I'll contact Ms. Anderson or
3 just may file our responses and have discussions
4 after that point.

5 But the lion's share of the requests
6 will be answered probably within 30 days.

7 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: Okay. So you're okay
8 with another status date in 30 days?

9 MR. ROTHSCHILD: Right. Because I think there
10 will be a few loose ends, and I don't know if
11 Ms. Anderson plans to have her responses to us by
12 30 days or just will report in as to where she
13 stands.

14 MS. ANDERSON: Yeah, to clarify, your Honor, I
15 would suggest just the 30-day period for updating
16 because I do not believe it will be possible for us
17 to have finished production within 30 days.

18 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: Okay.

19 MR. ROTHSCHILD: I believe the requests on both
20 sides are somewhat voluminous.

21 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: I can imagine.

22 All right. So 30 days takes us to the

1 week of July 18th. Let's look at -- that's an open
2 week for me. Any preference for a day?

3 MR. ROTHSCHILD: That week is a little dicey
4 for me. Can we make it like Tuesday the 26th?

5 MS. ANDERSON: That's available for Staff, your
6 Honor.

7 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: Okay. I have a
8 10:00 o'clock that day. We can either do a 9:00 or
9 afternoon.

10 MS. ANDERSON: Either of those times.

11 MR. ROTHSCHILD: Can we do like 3:00 o'clock?
12 That way I can go home afterward.

13 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: Let's make it 2:30.

14 MR. ROTHSCHILD: 2:30 is fine.

15 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: All right. So we are
16 going to continue the status on discovery to Tuesday,
17 July 26th at 2:30 p.m. here in Chicago.

18 So we will reconvene at that time for
19 status on discovery. Is there anything else on
20 discovery that anyone would like to bring up at this
21 point?

22 MS. ANDERSON: No, your Honor.

1 MR. ROTHSCHILD: Not at this time, your Honor.

2 JUDGE KIRKLAND-MONTAQUE: Okay. All right.
