AGREED ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE

On January 13, 2011, all parties appeared before the Court and announced that they had resolved this matter. By her statements on the record on January 13, 2011, and by her signature below, third-party defendant Sheryl Pick, having previously been served with a summons and third-party complaint, has generally appeared in this matter and has become a party for all purposes. Pursuant and subject to the resolution of the Air Park – Dallas Zoning Committee, adopted March 21, 2011, (a) third-party defendants Alfred Pick and Sheryl Pick may retain in place, at their own expense, their footbridge currently situated in front of their house located at 6345 Douglas Street, Plano, Texas, for so long as either of them continues to reside at that address; or, in addition and in the alternative, (b) third-party defendants Alfred Pick and Sheryl Pick may (again, at their own expense) replace their current footbridge with another footbridge

(in the same location) that conforms to the design previously approved by the Air Park – Dallas Zoning Committee in resolutions reflected in the minutes of the Zoning Committee dated April 13, 2007, and September 25, 2008, and in accordance with the terms of those resolutions.

All claims and causes of action that have been or could have been brought in this case by any party against any other opposing party are hereby DISMISSED with prejudice.

This shall constitute final judgment in this matter. All parties shall bear their own attorneys' fees and costs of court. The Court shall retain jurisdiction for the duration of this Order to enforce the terms of the Order.
