ORDER EXTENDING DISPOSITIVE MOTIONS DEADLINE

On December 7, 2023 and February 21, 2024, the Court held prehearing conferences. Based on discussions with the parties, the Court set a summary decision motion deadline of June 5, 2024.

On May 21, 2024, the parties filed a Joint Motion to Extend Dispositive Motion Due Date, requesting a 30-day extension on the deadline “to accommodate further settlement discussions.” Joint Mot. Extend 1. “OCAHO’s Rules of Practice and Procedure . . . do not provide specific standard for granting extensions, but the standard routinely applied is good cause.” *United States v. Space Exploration Techs. Corp.*, 18 OCAHO no. 1499, 5 (2023) (collecting cases and citing, inter alia, Fed. R. Civ. P. 6(b)(1) (stating good cause as a standard for when a party requests an extension after the original time expires)). The Court finds good cause to extend the deadline, noting it was jointly filed and the parties are engaged in exploring a mutually agreeable resolution. The revised deadline is July 8, 2024. Any response is due within 30 days.
