# CAMPING FEES

---

## All Campgrounds except Lydgate:

*(Anini, Anahola, & Salt Pond)*

Fee: \$3.00 per person per night

*Fee Exemptions:*

- *Hawai'i residents*
  - *Children under 18 years of age*
- (see KCC 19-2.5 for additional exemptions)*

## Lydgate Campground:

### Hawai'i residents

Camping site: \$5.00 per site per day

Group Camping site: \$75.00 per site per day

### Non-residents

Camping site: \$25.00 per site per day

Group Camping site: \$150.00 per site per day

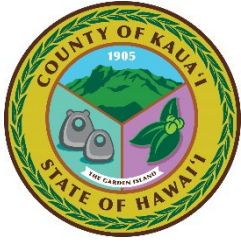
*\*Note: When both residents & non-residents occupy the same camp site, both daily fees apply (Ex. \$5.00 + \$25.00 = \$30.00 per day).*

# CAMPING INFORMATION

---

**A camping permit is required to camp in all County campgrounds. Permits are issued on a first-come, first-served basis.**

**Each campground will be closed for weekly maintenance at 10 a.m. on the days listed below and will reopen at noon the following day:**

**'Anini Beach Park – Wednesday**

**Anahola Beach Park – Thursday**

**Salt Pond Beach Park – Tuesday**

**Lydgate Campground – Tuesday & Wednesday (reopens Thursday)**

- \* Maximum of 10 individuals per permit, with the exception of the following designated campsites at Lydgate:
  - 10' x 10' (Nos. 1, 2, 3, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14) – max 5 per permit
  - Group Camping – no less than 20 & no more than 200
- \* Maximum of 2 sleeping tents per adult.
- \* Each permittee must display the permit on the outside of each tent.
- \* All campers must **SLEEP IN** tent.
- \* Mobile/Vehicle camping is **NOT** allowed.
- \* Animals are prohibited in the camping area.

**Campers are required to follow all DOPR Campground Guidelines and Rules.**
