Bonus funding for already funded programs

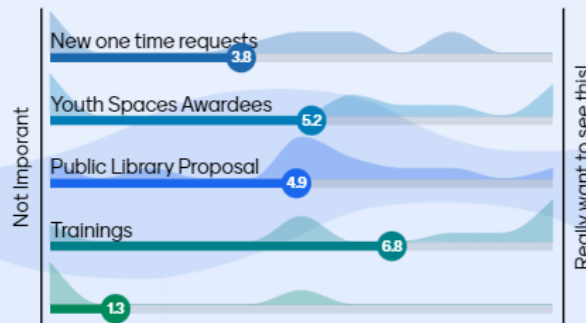
Families communicating as a whole and implementing life improving goals as a unit with assistance. Lots of ppl want to accomplish certain things but they dont understand or know where to start.
