

We currently have several projects in the pipeline such as:



- Rezoning for our Britton Rd property; we will be doing a Fuel Station and C-Store there



OTA Deputy Director, Joe Echelle, gave a presentation on OTA's plans to make intergovernmental agreements with Native American Tribes within Oklahoma, to obtain registered vehicle owner information so they can bill individuals for the use of OTA Turnpikes. Julie Porter, the CFO for the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority, will be at the Special General Council Meeting on October 7, to discuss all aspects of tolling and PlatePay. Mrs. Porter will also be available to answer any questions about the requested agreement for sharing registered vehicle information.
