**SUBJECT:** WIOA Service Delivery Incorporating Launch

The U.S. Department of Labor's TEGL 09-21 noted states' WIOA Title I-B program allotments for PY22, from which Idaho experienced a significant decrease in the allotment.

To address these coming deficits in program funding, the Workforce Development Council (WDC) proposed to change the state's means of WIOA service delivery for participants requesting training. To overcome PY22's WIOA allotment decrease, the WDC directs all WIOA service providers to use the Idaho LAUNCH program as the initial funding source for participant training payments. WIOA formula funds will provide supportive services to participants when appropriate.

PY22 Service Delivery Objectives:

- Use LAUNCH as the primary funding source for training.
- Expand dual participant enrollments in LAUNCH and WIOA.

We are preparing a statewide training to provide technical assistance to transition to this new service delivery approach.
