One MAFFS C-130 airtanker and support personnel from the 153rd Airlift Wing (Wyoming Air National Guard) and one MAFFS unit from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Colorado Air Force Reserve) have been deployed to Klamath Falls, OR to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Big Knife, Flathead Agency, BIA. CIMT (NR Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Niarada and Mill Pocket fires. Five miles east of Arlee, MT. Timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, torching and flanking. Numerous structures threatened. Road closures in effect.

Niarada, Flathead Agency, BIA. Twelve miles west of Elmo, MT. Grass and timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, torching and flanking. Numerous structures threatened. Trail closures in effect.

Mill Pocket, Flathead Agency, BIA. Fifteen miles west of Elmo, MT. Grass and timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Road closures in effect.

Colt, Southwestern Land Office, Montana DNR. CIMT (NR Team 1). CIMT (NR Team 5) mobilizing. Twelve miles northwest of Seeley Lake, MT. Timber. Active fire behavior with backing, single tree torching and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Middle Ridge, Flathead Agency, BIA. Fifteen miles west of Ronan, MT. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with creeping, backing and smoldering. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened.

Ridge, Flathead NF, USFS. Six miles east of Hungry Horse, MT. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with single tree torching, flanking and backing. Area closures in effect.

Communication Butte, Flathead Agency, BIA. Two miles north of Dixon, MT. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Black Butte, North Central Montana District, BLM. Twenty miles east of Landusky, MT. Timber, grass and brush. Moderate fire behavior with single tree torching, creeping and smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Midnight, Nez Perce-Clearwater NF, USFS. Thirteen miles east of Grangeville, ID. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Residences threatened.

East Fork, Kootenai NF, USFS. Twelve miles south of Trego, MT. Timber. Active fire behavior with short crown runs, short-range spotting and group torching. Road closures in effect.

Consalus, Idaho Panhandle NF, USFS. Eight miles southwest of Lamb Creek, ID. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with torching, backing and creeping. Residences threatened. Road closures in effect.

Eagle Bluff, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. IMT 2 (NW Team 7). Three miles south of Oroville, WA. Brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

Flat, Rogue River-Siskiyou NF, USFS. Transfer of command from IMT 1 (PNW Team 3) to CIMT (NR Team 2) will occur tomorrow. Two miles southeast of Agness, OR. Brush and timber. Predictive Services Discussion:

Isolated to scattered mixed wet and dry thunderstorms are expected from northern California into southern and eastern Oregon, mostly along and east of the Cascades. Scattered to widespread wet thunderstorms and showers are likely from northern Oregon and central and eastern Washington through central Idaho and southern Montana. Isolated to scattered mixed wet and dry thunderstorms are possible from the north Cascades into northwest Montana, with dry and breezy westerly winds in the Washington Cascade gaps into the Columbia Basin, but cloud cover remains uncertain over these areas. Hot, dry, and breezy conditions will continue across much of Texas, Oklahoma, and the Lower Mississippi Valley, while developing across much of the Southwest and greater Four Corners region. Isolated dry thunderstorms are possible over the Mogollon Rim in east-central Arizona into west-central New Mexico and in southeast New Mexico. Scattered to widespread thunderstorms are forecast from the northern High Plains extending southeast through the Mid-Mississippi Valley towards the central Gulf Coast and southeast Atlantic Coast. Widespread rain will fall over New England as well. Above normal temperatures will continue for much of Alaska, while isolated mixed wet and dry thunderstorms develop over the Copper Basin.
