CIMT (Florida State Gold Team) has been mobilized to Florida to assist with Hurricane Idalia support.

**Tiger Island**, Louisiana Office of Forestry. CIMT (SA Blue Team). IMT is also managing the Lions Camp Road, HWY 113 and Elizabeth fires. Started on private land 15 miles southwest of DeRidder, LA. Southern rough, timber and light slash. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Communities of Merryville and DeRidder threatened. Energy, communication and railroad infrastructure threatened.

**Lions Camp Road**, Louisiana Office of Forestry. Six miles south of Anacoco, LA. Southern rough, closed timber litter and light slash. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering.

**HWY 113**, Louisiana Office of Forestry. Fourteen miles northwest of Oakdale, LA. Southern rough, closed timber litter and timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Communication and energy infrastructure threatened.

**Elizabeth**, Louisiana Office of Forestry. Twelve miles northwest of Oakdale, LA. Southern rough, timber and medium slash. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering.

**Game Preserve**, Texas A&M Forest Service. CIMT (Florida State Red Team). IMT is also managing the Gist Road and Gibbs Forest fires. Started on private land 10 miles northwest of Huntsville, TX. Timber and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Residences threatened.

**Gist Road**, Texas A&M Forest Service. Started on private land 12 miles northeast of Beaumont, TX. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with torching. Residences threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

**Gibbs Forest**, Texas A&M Forest Service. Previously reported incident. Started on private land 13 miles west of Huntsville, TX. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, single tree torching and smoldering.

\* **Gunsmoke**, Texas A&M Forest Service. Started on private land 22 miles north of Rio Grande City, TX. Brush. Minimal fire behavior.

**Miller**, Louisiana Office of Forestry. Previously reported incident. Nineteen miles southwest of Leesville, LA. Timber. Active fire behavior. Structures threatened.

**Ida**, Kisatchie NF, USFS. Twelve miles southeast of Leesville, LA. Southern rough and timber. Minimal fire behavior.

**Limestone Gap**, Oklahoma DOF. Five miles north of Stringtown, OK. Timber and grass. No new information.

**Santa Ana**, Santa Ana National Wildlife Refuge, FWS. Four miles west of Hidalgo, TX. Chaparral, grass and brush. No new information.

**White Oak Mountain**, Oklahoma DOF. Eighteen miles northeast of Broken Bow, OK. Timber. No new information.

**Camp Creek**, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. IMT 1(NW Team 3). Ten miles northeast of Sandy, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Water infrastructure threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

**Lookout**, Willamette NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 2). IMT 1 (NW Team 2) is mobilizing. IMT is also managing the Horse Creek, Pothole and Bedrock fires. Thirty miles west of Sisters, OR. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, smoldering and backing. Communities of McKenzie Bridge and Blue River, energy and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Horse Creek**, Willamette NF, USFS. Thirty-one miles west of Sisters, OR. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Pothole**, Willamette NF, USFS. Twenty-seven miles southwest of Sisters, OR. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Bedrock**, Willamette NF, USFS. Twelve miles south of Vida, OR. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Tyee Ridge Complex** (3 fires), Central Unit, Oregon DOF. IMT 1 (ODF Team 3). Ten miles west of Sutherlin, OR. Timber and medium slash. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Residences threatened. Road closures in effect.

**Chilcoot**, Umpqua NF, USFS. Transfer of command from IMT 2 (NW Team 12) to IMT 2 (NW Team 6) will

occur tomorrow. IMT is also managing the Dinner, Brice Creek, Grizzly and Ridge fires. Twenty miles northeast of Glide, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Dinner**, Umpqua NF, USFS. Eight miles southwest of Oakridge, OR. Timber and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Brice Creek**, Umpqua NF, USFS. Eight miles southwest of Oakridge, OR. Timber and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Grizzly**, Umpqua NF, USFS. Eleven miles southwest of Oakridge, OR. Timber and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Ridge**, Umpqua NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles east of Glide, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Cowlitz Complex** (2 fires), Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. IMT 2 (CA Team 13). Nine miles east of Randle, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing and creeping. Road and trail closures in effect.

**Flat**, Rogue River-Siskiyou NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 3) and IMT 2 (GB Team 4). IMT is also managing the Anvil fire. Two miles southeast of Agness, OR. Brush, hardwood litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Anvil**, Rogue River-Siskiyou NF, USFS. Eight miles east of Port Orford, OR. Brush, closed timber litter and timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking and single tree torching. Residences threatened. Trail closures in effect.

Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and single tree torching. Several communities, energy, communication and water infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Happy Camp Complex** (4 fires), Klamath NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 2). Twenty-one miles west of Yreka, CA. Timber and heavy slash. ## **Predictive Services Discussion:**

Widespread showers and scattered thunderstorms will develop over much of the Southwest and Four Corners into central and west Texas. Widespread wetting rain is forecast, with the greatest potential for flooding and debris flows from northern and eastern Arizona into New Mexico. A cold front will move through the Deep South and Appalachians, with isolated showers in the Deep South, but scattered to widespread thunderstorms and showers for the Appalachians into the eastern Great Lakes and Northeast. Temperatures will cool behind the front, but hot temperatures will continue along the Gulf Coast ahead of the front with low to moderate afternoon relative humidity. Above normal temperatures will continue across much of the northern Great Basin and northern Rockies ahead of a cold front, while California and the Northwest cools to near normal behind the front with weak onshore flow. Westerly winds gusting to 25-35 mph across the Inland Northwest will create locally elevated fire weather conditions behind the front. Near to above normal temperatures will spread into much of the northern Plains as well, but below normal temperatures will continue in much of the Midwest.
