Pioneer, Southeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (CA Team 15). IMT is also managing the Easy fire. Started on private land 10 miles southeast of Stehekin, WA. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and backing. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Easy, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Seventeen miles west of Mazama, WA. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, backing and single tree torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Middle Fork, Crater Lake NP, NPS. Fourteen miles northeast of Union Creek, OR. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with group torching, flanking and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Trail closures in effect.

Lane 1, East Lane Unit, ODF. Transfer of command from CIMT (NC State Team 1) to IMT1 (ODF Team 1) will occur tomorrow. Fifteen miles southeast of Springfield, OR. Timber and light slash. Active fire behavior with group torching, uphill runs and backing. Structures threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Telephone, Malheur NF, USFS. Sixteen miles northeast of Burns, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with short crown runs, running and spotting. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sand, Malheur NF, USFS. Five miles southeast of Izee, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with short crown runs, running and isolated torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Willamette Complex (4 fires), Willamette NF, USFS. CIMT (AK Team 3) and CIMT (CA Team 13). IMT is also managing the Ore fire. Eight miles southeast of Oakridge, OR. Brush and timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, group torching and spotting. Infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Ore, Willamette NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Blue River, OR. Brush and timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, group torching and spotting. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sandstone, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 2). IMT is also managing the Whisky Creek fire. Nine miles southwest of Ripplebrook, OR. Timber, medium slash and chaparral. Active fire behavior with torching and wind-driven runs. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Whisky Creek, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Six miles southeast of Cascade Locks, OR. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with single tree torching, backing and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Warner Peak, Sheldon-Hart Mountain NWR, FWS. CIMT (SW Team 1) mobilizing. Thirty-two miles northeast of Lakeview, OR. Brush and grass. Active fire behavior with running, spotting and torching. Structures threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Red, Deschutes NF, USFS. Eighteen miles west of Crescent, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, single tree torching and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Swawilla I, Colville Agency, BIA. Ten miles southwest of Keller, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, backing and single tree torching. Numerous residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Durkee, Vale District, BLM. Started on private land one mile west of Durkee, OR. Grass and timber. Minimal fire behavior. Structures and sage-grouse habitat threatened.

Elk Lane, Prineville District, BLM. Six miles west of Madras, OR. Brush, grass and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Soldier Creek, Vale District, BLM. Sixteen miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior. Sage-grouse habitat threatened.

Salmon Creek, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Started on private land three miles southeast of Conconully, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened.

Predictive Services Discussion:

National Predictive Services Outlook

Light westerly winds are expected west of the Cascade Crest today with higher relative humidity and cooler conditions, but winds will be gusty on the east side of the crest, especially through the gaps. Very dry conditions will continue away from the coast and monsoon influence with minimum relative humidity of 5-20% and breezy westerly winds of 12-20 mph with gusts to 35 mph across central and northern California into the northern Great Basin. Poor overnight recoveries are expected for many of these areas, as well. Above normal temperatures will remain west of the Divide, with much cooler temperatures east of the Divide into the Great Lakes.

Scattered mainly wet thunderstorms from the monsoon will develop across the Southwest, southern Great Basin, and Colorado, with more isolated chances into southeast California. Heavy rain and possible flooding is most likely in Colorado and northern New Mexico. Weak troughing off the Northwest coast combined with limited moisture will lead to an increased threat of isolated dry thunderstorms over eastern Oregon and east into western Wyoming in the afternoon, with a better chance of mixed wet and dry thunderstorms near the northern Cascades towards the Canadian border. Cooler conditions with higher relative humidity are expected in Texas and Oklahoma along with a chance of showers, especially in northern Oklahoma. The remnants of Debby will continue moving to the north bringing heavy rain and areas of flooding through the Mid-Atlantic and Northeast.
