Pioneer, Southeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (CA Team 15). IMT is also managing the Easy fire. Started on private land 10 miles southeast of Stehekin, WA. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and backing. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Easy, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Seventeen miles west of Mazama, WA. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, backing and single tree torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Crazy Creek, Ochoco NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (SW Team 5) to CIMT (CA Team 1) will occur tomorrow. Sixteen miles northeast of Paulina, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, group torching and spotting. Numerous residences and sage-grouse habitat threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Diamond Complex (8 fires), Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 3). IMT is also managing the Middle Fork fire. Eighteen miles southwest of Chemult, OR. Timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, torching and short-range spotting. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Middle Fork, Crater Lake NP, NPS. Fourteen miles northeast of Union Creek, OR. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with group torching, flanking and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Trail closures in effect.

Lane 1, East Lane Unit, ODF. Transfer of command from CIMT (NC State Team 1) to IMT1 (ODF Team 1) will occur tomorrow. Fifteen miles southeast of Springfield, OR. Timber and light slash. Active fire behavior with group torching, uphill runs and backing. Structures threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Falls, Malheur NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (AK Team 1) to CIMT (NW Team 2) will occur tomorrow. IMT is also managing the Telephone and Sand fires. Twenty-six miles northwest of Burns, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with short crown runs, running and spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Telephone, Malheur NF, USFS. Sixteen miles northeast of Burns, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with short crown runs, running and spotting. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sand, Malheur NF, USFS. Five miles southeast of Izee, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with short crown runs, running and isolated torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Willamette Complex (4 fires), Willamette NF, USFS. CIMT (AK Team 3) and CIMT (CA Team 13). IMT is also managing the Ore fire. Eight miles southeast of Oakridge, OR. Brush and timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, group torching and spotting. Infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Ore, Willamette NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Blue River, OR. Brush and timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, group torching and spotting. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sandstone, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 2). IMT is also managing the Whisky Creek fire. Nine miles southwest of Ripplebrook, OR. Timber, medium slash and chaparral. Active fire behavior with torching and wind-driven runs. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Whisky Creek, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Six miles southeast of Cascade Locks, OR. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with single tree torching, backing and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Retreat, Southeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (CA Team 14). Started on private land 14 miles southeast of Naches, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Numerous structures, communication and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Homestead Complex (6 Fires), Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 8). Thirty miles northeast of Glide, OR. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Battle Mountain Complex (2 fires), Pendleton Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (SW Team 3). Eight miles north of Ukiah, OR. Grass, hardwood litter and timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, creeping and torching. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Cougar Creek, Southeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (NW Team 12). Twenty-three miles southwest of Asotin, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and flanking. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Lone Rock, Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (SW Team 2). IMT is also managing the Courtrock fire. Started on county land 10 miles southeast of Condon, OR. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Courtrock, Fossil Unit, ODF. Seven miles south of Monument, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Area and road closures in effect.

Williams Mine, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 13). Four miles northwest of Trout Lake, WA. Timber, medium slash and chaparral. Extreme fire behavior with running, group torching and short-range spotting. Community of Trout Lake threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Town Gulch, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 2). Eight miles north of Richland, OR. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and backing. Several communities threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Warner Peak, Sheldon-Hart Mountain NWR, FWS. CIMT (SW Team 1) mobilizing. Thirty-two miles northeast of Lakeview, OR. Brush and grass. Active fire behavior with running, spotting and torching. Structures threatened. Area and road closures in effect.

Red, Deschutes NF, USFS. Eighteen miles west of Crescent, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, single tree torching and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Swawilla I, Colville Agency, BIA. Ten miles southwest of Keller, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, backing and single tree torching. Numerous residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Durkee, Vale District, BLM. Started on private land one mile west of Durkee, OR. Grass and timber. Minimal fire behavior. Structures and sage-grouse habitat threatened.

Elk Lane, Prineville District, BLM. Six miles west of Madras, OR. Brush, grass and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Soldier Creek, Vale District, BLM. Sixteen miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior. Sage-grouse habitat threatened.

Salmon Creek, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Started on private land three miles southeast of Conconully, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened.

Porcupine, Burns District, BLM. Thirty-five miles southeast of Burns, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Sage-grouse habitat threatened. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Microwave Tower, The Dalles Unit, Oregon DOF. Five miles southwest of Mosier, OR. Grass and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Cliff Mountain, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles east of Joseph, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area closure in effect.

Paddock, Boise District, BLM. Twenty-one miles northeast of Payette, ID. Grass and brush. Extreme fire behavior with short-range spotting, uphill and wind-driven runs. Numerous structures and sage-grouse habitat threatened. Evacuations in effect.

Bulldog, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 5). IMT is also managing the Nellie, Anderson, Wapiti and Bulltrout fires. Eight miles north of Garden Valley, ID. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with uphill runs and single tree torching. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Nellie, Boise NF, USFS. Twenty-three miles north of Idaho City, ID. Timber. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs and running.

Anderson, Boise NF, USFS. Eight miles west of Lowman, ID. Timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs and group torching.

Wapiti, Boise NF, USFS. Fourteen miles west of Stanley, ID. Timber. Active fire behavior with group torching, spotting and flanking. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Bulltrout, Boise NF, USFS. Fifteen miles northwest of Stanley, ID. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Boulder, Boise NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (GB Team 7) to CIMT (GB Team 2) will occur tomorrow. IMT is also managing the Wolf Creek, Snag and Dollar fires. Nine miles southwest of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with group torching, spotting and flanking. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wolf Creek, Payette NF, USFS. Eleven miles northwest of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with group torching, spotting and flanking. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Snag, Boise NF, USFS. Ten miles east of Cascade, ID. Timber. Active fire behavior with crowning, running and spotting. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Dollar, Boise NF, USFS. Eighteen miles northeast of Cascade, ID. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with group torching, spotting and flanking. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Limepoint, Payette NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 1). CIMT (GB Team 4) is mobilizing. IMT is also managing the Cliff Mountain fire in the Northwest Area. Three miles southwest of Cuprum, ID. Light westerly winds are expected west of the Cascade Crest today with higher relative humidity and cooler conditions, but winds will be gusty on the east side of the crest, especially through the gaps. Very dry conditions will continue away from the coast and monsoon influence with minimum relative humidity of 5-20% and breezy westerly winds of 12-20 mph with gusts to 35 mph across central and northern California into the northern Great Basin. Poor overnight recoveries are expected for many of these areas, as well. Above normal temperatures will remain west of the Divide, with much cooler temperatures east of the Divide into the Great Lakes.

Scattered mainly wet thunderstorms from the monsoon will develop across the Southwest, southern Great Basin, and Colorado, with more isolated chances into southeast California. Heavy rain and possible flooding is most likely in Colorado and northern New Mexico. Weak troughing off the Northwest coast combined with limited moisture will lead to an increased threat of isolated dry thunderstorms over eastern Oregon and east into western Wyoming in the afternoon, with a better chance of mixed wet and dry thunderstorms near the northern Cascades towards the Canadian border. Cooler conditions with higher relative humidity are expected in Texas and Oklahoma along with a chance of showers, especially in northern Oklahoma. The remnants of Debby will continue moving to the north bringing heavy rain and areas of flooding through the Mid-Atlantic and Northeast.
