153<sup>rd</sup> Airlift Wing (WY Air National Guard), 302<sup>nd</sup> Airlift Wing (CO Air Force Reserve), 146<sup>th</sup> Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard), and 152<sup>nd</sup> Airlift Wing (NV Air National Guard).

Sixty fireline management personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest Area.

**Williams Mine**, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 13). Four miles northwest of Trout Lake, WA. Brush, timber and heavy slash. Active fire behavior with backing, flanking and creeping. Communities and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Diamond Complex (7 fires)**, Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 3). CIMT (CA Team 4) mobilizing. IMT is also managing the Middle Fork fire. Eighteen miles southwest of Chemult, OR. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Middle Fork**, Crater Lake NP, NPS. Fourteen miles northeast of Union Creek, OR. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Dixon**, Umpqua NF, USFS. IMT 1 (ODF Team 2). Eighteen miles east of Canyonville, OR. Timber and slash. Moderate fire behavior with backing and smoldering. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area road and trail closures in effect.

**Willamette Complex (4 fires),** Willamette NF, USFS. CIMT (AK Team 3) and CIMT (CA Team 13). IMTs are also managing the Ore fire. Eight miles southeast of Oakridge, OR. Brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Ore**, Willamette NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Blue River, OR. Brush and timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, backing and isolated torching. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Pioneer**, Southeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (CA Team 15). CIMT (NW Team 3) mobilizing. IMT is also managing the Easy fire. Started on private land 10 miles southeast of Stehekin, WA. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Easy**, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Seventeen miles west of Mazama, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Warner Peak**, Sheldon-Hart Mountain NWR, FWS. CIMT (SW Team 1). Thirty-two miles northeast of Lakeview, OR. Brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with uphill runs, torching and short-range spotting. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect. Sagegrouse habitat threatened. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Retreat**, Southeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (CA Team 14). Started on private land 14 miles southeast of Naches, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Sandstone**, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 2). CIMT (NW Team 10) is mobilizing. IMT is also managing the Whisky Creek fire. Nine miles southwest of Ripplebrook, OR. Timber and chaparral. Minimal fire behavior with backing and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Whisky Creek, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Six miles southeast of Cascade Locks, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Lane 1**, East Lane Unit, ODF. IMT 1 (ODF Team 1). Fifteen miles southeast of Springfield, OR. Timber, closed timber litter and light slash. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, torching and spotting. Structures, energy and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Falls**, Malheur NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 2). IMT is also managing the Telephone fire. Twenty-six miles northwest of Burns, OR. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, smoldering and isolated torching. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Telephone**, Malheur NF, USFS. Sixteen miles northeast of Burns, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures and sage-grouse habitat threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Crazy Creek**, Ochoco NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 1). Sixteen miles northeast of Paulina, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, backing and creeping. Residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Homestead Complex (6 Fires)**, Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 8). CIMT (NR Team 6) is mobilizing. Thirty miles northeast of Glide, OR. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and short-range spotting. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Battle Mountain Complex (2 fires)**, Pendleton Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (SW Team 3). Eight miles north of Ukiah, OR. Grass, hardwood litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Town Gulch**, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 2). Eight miles north of Richland, OR. Timber and grass. Moderate fire behavior with flanking and smoldering. Several communities threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

#### **Predictive Services Discussion:**

Low pressure will strengthen off the Northwest coast, with southwesterly flow increasing across southeast California, central/southern Nevada, and western Utah. Southwesterly winds of 12-25 mph with gusts 25-40 mph amid relative humidity of 5-20% are likely across the northern Mojave Desert into southern Nevada and bringing elevated conditions. Breezy and dry westerly winds are likely across northeast California into western Nevada, then across southeast Wyoming as well. Isolated to scattered showers and thunderstorms are likely far northeast Washington into north-central Montana, and in Arizona south of the Mogollon Rim. The Northwest will remain seasonably mild and dry with relative humidity remaining above 15% east of the Cascade Crest and 30% west of the crest.

Maximum temperatures 95-108°F are likely for much of New Mexico into the southern Plains and Gulf Coast. Very dry conditions are also expected, especially for portions of North Texas and southeast New Mexico as RH falls to 15-25%. A frontal system will bring showers and thunderstorms to the Tennessee and Ohio Valleys into the Great Lakes, while isolated thunderstorms will continue for the Lower Mississippi Valley with small rainfall footprints, where new ignitions are possible.
