Dear Providers,

In celebration of [National Infant Immunization Week](#), the New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (NYC Health Department) would like to announce the Immunization Provider Honor Roll award recipients for 2024. To be honored, the provider must be enrolled in the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program and must have satisfied the following requirements by April 17, 2024:

- Be in good standing with all VFC program requirements;
- Have at least 10 children in the 2-year-old cohort, 13-year-old cohort, or, if applicable, both age cohorts, depending on the patient-population reported by the practice; and
- Meet one or both of the following metrics:
 - Reached at least 90% coverage — as calculated from Citywide Immunization Registry (CIR) data — for the 4 DTaP: 3 Polio: 1 MMR: 4 Hib*: 3 Hep B: 1 Varicella: 4 PCV (4:3:1:4:3:1:4) vaccine series, assessed by 2nd birthday, among patients aged 24–35 months, if they see this age group at their practice
 - Reached at least 80% coverage — as calculated from CIR data — for the 1 Tdap: 1 MenACWY: 2/3 HPV completion (1:1:2/3) series among 13-year-olds by their 13th birthday, if they see this age group at their practice

Award recipients will receive a certificate signed by the Commissioner of Health and the Bureau of Immunization Assistant Commissioner and a gift box.


