



Intelligence Community Inspectors General Forum Notice

U.S. Intelligence Community (IC) professionals, both government and contractor personnel, are dedicated to ensuring our nation's security. Everyday their collective knowledge, experience, and expertise support missions that protect and fortify the very fabric of freedom that U.S. citizens enjoy. To do so effectively in this information age, IC professionals often work in secret to preserve sensitive information, sources of intelligence, and methods of collection. The recent unauthorized disclosures of classified information at NSA demonstrate the severity of the consequences to the national security when such information is not protected.

Working in secret does not require IC professionals to remain silent if they believe that they have legitimate information of fraud, waste, or abuse in the IC. IC professionals should report such concerns to their Inspector General (IG).

The IC as a whole and each IC agency has an independent IG with security-cleared personnel and secure computer networks to receive complaints of wrongdoing and to ensure that such concerns are appropriately and immediately addressed. Further, IC professionals can work with an IG office to provide classified complaints of an urgent concern to appropriate congressional committees. These IG reporting mechanisms provide protections for classified information and national security interests. In addition, reporting to the IGs protects IC professionals from reprisal for reporting fraud, waste, or abuse.

The IC IGs encourage IC professionals to report their concerns via the respective Hotline contact information provided.
