Complaint Number	A Complaint Number is assigned to any complaint made by a complainant that was received by fax, telephone, email, or mail that have been logged into DHS-OIG Office of Investigations' official system of records: Enforcement Data System (EDS). A complaint number is denoted with a "C" in front of the 7-digit record number.
INVESTIGATION NITIMAER	An Investigation Number is assigned to all investigations that are logged into EDS. An investigation number is denoted with an "I" in from of the 7-digit record number.
Opened Date	Opened date in relation to a <i>Complaint</i> is the date of when the complaint was entered into EDS.
	Opened date in relation to an <i>Investigation</i> is the date of when the complaint was converted into an investigation and is assigned to a criminal investigator.
Closed Date	Closed date in relation to a Complaint is the date when the OIG determines the "final" disposition of the complaint.
	Closed date in relation to an <i>Investigation</i> is the date the OIG closes the <i>investigation</i> and issues a final Report of Investigation (ROI), (if applicable).
Narrative	A Narrative is a summary of the complaint made and was sent to DHS-OIG.
-	Only applicable to an Investigation, a Violation Description is the criminal, civil, or administrative statutory citation of the violation that the subject is alleged to have made.

Definitions of Column Labels

Allegation Category	An Allegation Category is given to every complaint or investigation that is logged into EDS. Depending on the basis of the complaint/investigation narrative, (1) of the four (4) primary <i>allegation categories</i> is chosen to represent it.
	 Civil Rights / Civil Liberties Employee Corruption Miscellaneous Program Fraud / Financial Crimes
Allegation	An Allegation is a more specific sub-set categorization given to the complaint or investigation of any of the four (4) aforementioned "Allegation Categories".
Allegation Detail	An Allegation Detail further represents a more specific sub-set categorization of an "Allegation."
Allegation Type	This represents a more specific categorization sub-set of any of the aforementioned "Allegation Details."
Disposition Type	A Disposition Type is only given to an Investigation to denote if there was any of the following:
	Criminal Disposition (i.e. some judicial action)
	Civil Disposition (i.e. some civil judicial action)
	Administrative Disposition (i.e. some corrective action by the affected DHS Component)
Violation Description	Only applicable to an Investigation, a Violation Description is the criminal, civil, or administrative statutory citation of the violation that the subject is alleged to have made.
