Since Clara Barton founded the American Red Cross in 1881, the organization has harnessed the compassion and determination of women to deliver its lifesaving mission. For more than a decade, the organization's Tiffany Circle has continued this legacy by advancing the Red Cross mission through investments of time, talent and treasure.



# Tiffany Circle Members Make an Impact

Since the Tiffany Circle was founded in 2007, its members have made a lifesaving impact in their local communities, across the country and around the world. Over 1,200 members strong, these women have collectively provided extraordinary support — more than \$230 million — to fulfill the mission of the Red Cross.

Home fires are the biggest disaster threat Americans face, taking the lives of seven people every day. Tiffany Circle members like **Nisha Baxi** are making households safer by going door-to-door, installing free smoke alarms and helping families create their escape plans.

Every eight minutes, the Red Cross responds to a home fire or other disasters. During large-scale disasters, dedicated Tiffany Circle members like **Maya Rogers and Megan Erk** engage their peers in supporting relief efforts and roll up their sleeves to deliver food, shelter and care.

Every two seconds, someone in America needs lifesaving blood. To meet this need, Tiffany Circle members like **Nichole Jordan** give lifesaving blood products. Furthermore, Tiffany Circle members collectively gave \$1.3 million to the Red Cross Sickle Cell Initiative to help fulfill the blood product needs of those facing medical emergencies like sickle cell disease.

Inspired by the work of the American Red Cross-supported Measles & Rubella Partnership, members **Kathy Flynn and Sara Horein** have traveled to Kenya, Malawi and Indonesia to participate in these vaccination programs. Since 2001, we have helped vaccinate more than 3.86 billion children in 88 countries against Measles and Rubella, helping reduce measles deaths by a staggering 82% worldwide.

Tiffany Circle members like **Teri Pollitt** also support our Service to the Armed Forces program, providing essential baby items to military families welcoming new children and preparing critical supplies to veterans through VA Hospital partnerships. Every day, the Red Cross provides about 1,400 services to members of the military, veterans and their families.

Finally, communities across the country are safer because of members who have been trained in health and safety courses, such as **Jennifer McCormick** who learned Hands-Only CPR at the 2023 Tiffany Circle Summit. On average, over 14,000 people each day receive lifesaving Red Cross training in first aid, water safety and other skills.

Building on this impact, the Tiffany Circle strives to cultivate a community that empowers servant leaders, embraces inclusivity and is a leading charity of choice for women. The Tiffany Circle strategic plan focuses on mission support, leveraging the influence of women in philanthropy, diversity and inclusion, and education and outreach.

# **Treasured History**

The Tiffany Circle name and its threshold contribution of \$10,000 have historic significance. The name was inspired by the breathtaking Tiffany windows within the American Red Cross national headquarters in Washington, D.C.

These works of art were commissioned from the Louis Comfort Tiffany Studios in 1917 and were paid for through a \$5,000 gift from the women of the north and a \$5,000 gift from the women of the south as an act of reconciliation and hope.

Today, these beautiful windows are featured in Tiffany Circle Hall, honoring the many contributions of the Tiffany Circle and its generous members.
