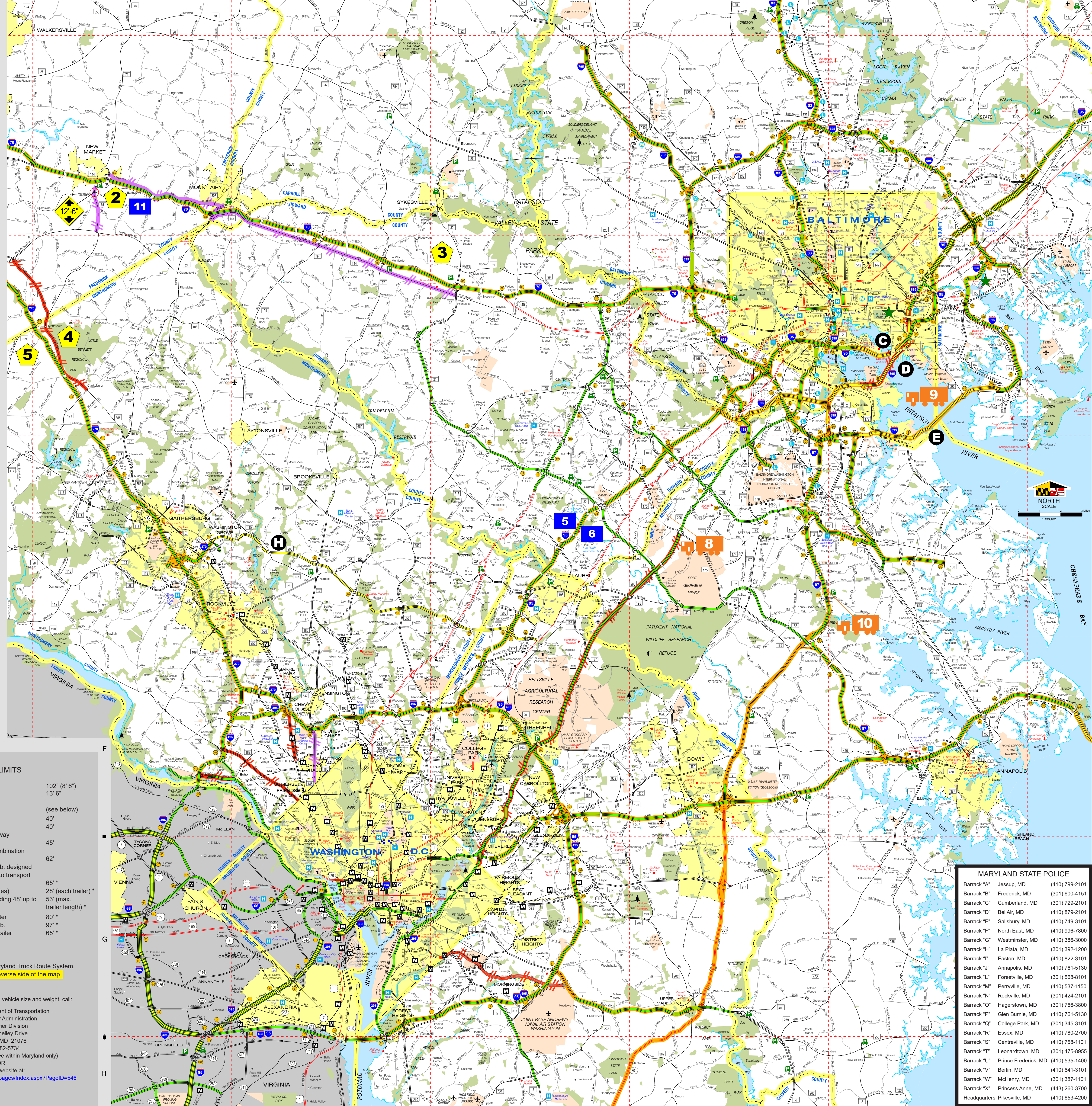

FEDERAL BRIDGE FORMULA FOR MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT (GVW) & AXLE WEIGHTS

Maryland follows the Federal Bridge Formula regarding the maximum allowable GVW and axle weights. Additionally, some weights are governed by the following:

NUMBER OF AXLES	MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE GROSS WEIGHT (IN POUNDS)
Vehicles registered less than 73,000 pounds	22,400 pounds per axle
Vehicles registered more than 73,000 pounds	20,000 pounds per axle

THE BRIDGE FORMULA FOR MARYLAND IS AS FOLLOWS:

$$W = 500 \left[\frac{LN + 1}{LN - 1} + 12N + 36 \right]$$

As a working example of how the Formula is determined, see below:

Actual weight = 12,000 + 17,000 + 17,000 = 46,000 lbs.

Check of axles 1 through 3, where N = 3 axles and L = 20 ft.

$$W = 500 \left[\frac{LN + 1}{LN - 1} + 12N + 36 \right] = 500 \left[\frac{3(20) + 1}{3(20) - 1} + (12(3) + 36) \right] = 51,000 \text{ lbs. Weight Allowed}$$

CIVIL RIGHTS UNDER TITLE VI

Commercial vehicle safety in Maryland is enhanced by a comprehensive program of enforcement provided by the partnership of over 20 state and local enforcement agencies conducting inspections, traffic stops, and in-terminal compliance and safety audits. Maryland has a very aggressive enforcement program, weighing over 1,000,000 trucks and inspecting more than 100,000 trucks every year. The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) State Highway Administration and all of their enforcement partners are committed to conducting commercial vehicle enforcement in compliance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and related statutes. All enforcement actions are conducted in strict compliance with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations and all of the Federal Highway Administration size and weight laws without regard to race, national origin, age, color, sex, disability, limited English proficiency or income level. OVERSIZE OR OVERWEIGHT VEHICLES REQUIRING A HAULING PERMIT
Oversize and/or Overweight Hauling Permits are ONLY AVAILABLE IF YOUR VEHICLE IS CARRYING A NON-DIVISIBLE LOAD AND IT EXCEEDS THE FOLLOWING LIMITS:

WEIGHT: Exceeds the bridge formula for the vehicle or vehicle combination

WIDTH: 102" (8'6")

HEIGHT: 13'6" (see below)

LENGTH: Indivisible loads over 70' require a permit. Piling, poles and mill logs require a permit exceeding 75'. Indivisible loads up to 70' may be moved during daylight hours without a permit on a combination vehicle.

HAULING PERMIT CONDITIONS: (NOT TO EXCEED)

Weight: Single Axle - 27,000 lbs.
Tandem Axle - 54,000 lbs.
For weights of 120,000 lbs. to 150,000 lbs., travel on interstate routes only.

**Weights exceeding these parameters may require an engineering study.

Escorts: Single - more than 13' wide unless manufactured housing unit - more than 85' long, 14'6" high or more (pole vehicle) - more than 60 ton gross weight - construction equipment over 12' wide traveling off the interstate - when weather or road conditions justify the requirement

Two Escort - 14' wide or more including manufactured housing units - 140' long or more traveling a road too narrow to allow other vehicles to pass safely, traveling against traffic that will have to be diverted or stopped - weather or road conditions justify the requirement

Police Escort - 16' high, 16' wide, 140' long, 150K GVW

Travel Time: Moves for loads up to and including 150K GVW, 12' wide, 14'6" high, 90' long may move from Monday, 12:01am to Saturday, 12:00pm noon EST. **All other loads** are one-half hour after sunrise and one-half hour before sunset.

NO SUNDAY TRAVEL.

CURFEW: The permittee or user may move any vehicle and load, together, exceeds 45 tons gross weight or is 100' or more in length, or 12' or more in width over I-495 and I-83 (Capital Beltway) or I-695 (Baltimore Beltway) from 9:00am to 3:30pm. If 14' wide or more, 9:00am to 3:30pm on any highway. Maryland has many toll, bridge, and tunnel restrictions. Make sure you contact the toll facility before you make your move. For further information, call the Permit Office, toll-free (within Maryland only) at 1-800-846-6435. Curfew restrictions will be noted on the permit.

Height: 13'6"

Length: Single Unit Truck or Bus - 40'
Travel Trailer - 40'
Bus operated on the State Highway or Interstate System - 45'
Cargo carrying power unit in combination with another vehicle - 62'

Truck or tractor-semi-trailer comb. designed for and engaged exclusively to transport autos or locals - 65'
Tractor-semi-trailer-trailer (doubles) - 28' (each trailer) *
Tractor pulling semitrailer exceeding 48' up to 53' in length - 53' (max. trailer length) *
Stinger-steer auto/boat transporter - 80'
Saddle-mount or full-mount comb. - 97'
Maxi-cube comb. with 34' semitrailer - 65'

* Vehicles must travel on the Maryland Truck Route System.

- ENVIRONMENTAL ENFORCEMENT PROGRAMS**
- 1) **DIESEL EMISSION TESTING PROGRAM**
Maryland has a Diesel Emission Testing Program to get smoky trucks off the road. Test failures will receive an equipment repair order/vehicle inspection report.
 - 2) **NOISE ABATEMENT PROGRAM**
Maryland has a roadside Noise Abatement Program to enforce exhaust systems.

MARYLAND ENGINE IDLING LAW FOR ALL MOTOR VEHICLES

Maximum idling time - 5 min	Exemptions: * Heating, cooling, or auxiliary equipment * Conform to manufacturer's specifications * Accumpler intended use
Fine - Not < \$500.00	

- WHAT AM I REQUIRED TO DO AFTER HAVING A CRASH?**
- Maryland law requires the operator of a vehicle involved in a crash to STOP or return immediately to the scene of the crash until the following requirements have been met:
- 1) Render assistance to, and/or arrange for medical transportation for any person injured.
 - 2) Exchange your name, address, registration number of the vehicle you are driving, and name and address of the insurance carrier to involved parties and the police.
 - 3) Upon request, exhibit your driver's license to the parties and police. If there are no injuries, MOVE VEHICLES OUT OF THE TRAVEL LANES TO THE SIDE OF THE HIGHWAY.
