FIRST AMENDMENT TO SPECIAL USE PERMIT

This First Amendment to the Special Use Permit (First Amendment) is made and entered into by and between the City of San Diego (City) and Carmel Valley Tennis Club, a California Nonprofit Organization (Permittee), also referred to individually as "Party" and collectively as the "Parties."

RECITALS

- 2. This First Amendment will be effective when signed by both parties and approved by the City Attorney in accordance with Charter section 40.
 - 3. The current SUP is replaced with the revised and updated SUP. However, the Terms requiring a Permit Fee and a Sub-license Fee will not become effective until this revised and updated SUP is renewed after the expiration of the Term period.
