


1 This consolidated case consists of the Group I test cases involving water claims for stock  
2 watering, stockponds, and domestic use. Among the cases, is a set of cases referred to as *In re*  
3 *Pyeatt Group of Cases*, Contested Case No. W1-11-212. In order to separately consider each of the  
4 watershed file reports prepared by the Arizona Department of Water Resources that have been  
5 consolidated under Contested Case W1-11-0212, the consolidated case must be separated from this  
6 contested case.

8 **IT IS ORDERED** that contested case *In re Pyeatt Group of Cases*, W1-11-0212 shall be  
9 separated from this contested case and all future filings for *In re Pyeatt Group of Cases* shall be filed  
10 under case number W1-11-0212.

11 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the stay imposed in this case is vacated with respect to *In*  
12 *re Pyeatt Group of Cases*, W1-11-0212.
