This contested case is one of the many cases in the General Stream Adjudication for the 27 28

San Pedro River Watershed to determine legal rights to water. Other cases in which claims have been made to water in the San Pedro River Watershed have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or awaiting initiation. One of the purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the legal rights of those persons who filed claims to use appropriable water in the San Pedro River Watershed. The General Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria and Upper Santa Cruz watersheds.

On October 17, 1979, Lucian I. and Charlotte S. Powers filed Statement of Claimant 39-2101 asserting rights to water for irrigation and domestic use. The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated those claims and prepared a report known as Watershed File Report No. 111-23-AC-057 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991) ("San Pedro HSR"). A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment A.

The WFR found no water used for irrigation on the property and did not identify any potential water rights for use of appropriable water on the land. Consideration will be given in this case to the claims made for water rights that are the subject of the WFR and to the objections filed to the WFR.

Claimants & Landowners

Lucian I. Powers and Charlotte S. Powers filed the relevant Statement of Claimant in this case. The public records of Arizona Department of Water Resources do not include an assignment of the Statement of Claimant from Lucian I. Powers or Charlotte Powers to any subsequent property owner. Accordingly, Lucian I. and Charlotte S. Powers are the Claimants in this contested case.

The WFR names William W. Hicks as the owner of the property investigated by the WFR. The maps prepared as a part of the San Pedro HSR do not, however, include a separate map showing the boundaries of WFR. The records of the Cochise County Assessor list the

trustees of the William W. and Jojuana Hicks Revocable Trust as the owner of tax parcel 104-02-005. A copy of a map prepared by the Cochise County Assessor showing tax parcel 104-02-005 is attached as Attachment B.

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re William W. Hicks* and it will determine the claims to appropriable water rights investigated in and objections to Watershed File Report 111-23-AC-057 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be found under the case name and number on the following website: http://www.superiorcourt.maricopa.gov/SuperiorCourt/GeneralStreamAdjudication/whatsNew.asp
- 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimants, all persons who filed objections to the WFR, and current landowners, who are included in Attachment C, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment C to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County

 Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the

 Court-approved mailing list.

conduct discovery, submit prehearing motions, and hold a trial. No party shall conduct any discovery or file any motions prior to the Status Conference.

The Status Conference shall be held on **September 2, 2021 at 2:10 p.m**. The Status Conference shall be held using the Court Connect program. 
