Pedro LLC. This contested case is one of the many cases in the General Stream Adjudication

for the San Pedro River watershed. Other cases in which claims have been made to water in the San Pedro River watershed have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or awaiting initiation.

The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the rights of those persons who filed statement of claimants for rights to use water from the San Pedro watershed. The General Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria and Upper Santa Cruz watersheds. Persons who fail to timely file statements of claimant will forfeit any rights to the use of water in this river system and source.

Claimants

In this case, First National Bank of Arizona and Charles J. Leftault, as co-trustees filed Statements of Claimant 39-2256, 39-2257, 39-2260, 39-2262, and 39-2263 (SOCs) claiming rights to water for irrigation, domestic, and stock uses on land located in the north half of section 15 Township 23S Range 22E. The Arizona Department of Water Resources investigated the claims and the water uses on the land and issued Watershed File Report 111-24-CBB-004 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The Arizona Department of Water Resources identified potential water rights for a domestic and an irrigation use and listed four wells as the sources of water for the uses. The Arizona Department of Water Resources later determined that the wells labelled as Wells W1, W2, W3, and W5 are located in the subflow zone. A copy of the watershed file report is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map prepared for the WFR is attached as Attachment B. The land included in the boundaries of the WFR is labelled on the map as "(4)".

After the WFR was issued, objections were filed to the findings in that report. The purpose of this case to consider the claims made for water rights that were investigated in the WFR and resolve the objections to the WFR.

Landowner

First National Bank of Arizona and Charles Leftault, as co-trustees were identified in the WFR as the landowner. The public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not include an assignment of the SOCs to any succeeding landowner. According to the Cochise County Treasurer, tax parcel 104-34-002A is currently owned by Rancho del Rio San Pedro LLC. A copy of the map prepared by the Cochise County Treasurer is attached as Attachment C.

- Litigants. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimants, the current landowner, all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file report who are listed on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.




