DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: Contested case W1-11-1986 initiated, ADWR directed to map location of wells, and status conference set for June 19, 2019.

This Order initiates a contested case to consider the claims and resolve objections to Watershed File Report 112-17-BDA-007 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The WFR identifies potential water rights for irrigation and small reservoirs for the land described in the WFR as located in sections 23 and 24 Township 17S Range 20E. The identified sources of water for the claimed uses were a diversion into the Pomerene Water Users Association canal from the San Pedro River and

1 wells. A copy of the watershed file report is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map of
2 section 23 prepared for the WFR is attached as Attachment B.

4 **Background**

5 Until October 5, 2018, this case was consolidated and a part of that group of cases
6 known as *In re Pomerene Water Users Association*, contested case no. W1-11-1676. In that
7 case, the court scheduled a status conference for June 28, 2017 to identify the proper parties.
8 At the status conference, counsel for the Pomerene Water Users Association was given until
9 October 2, 2017 to provide documentation concerning the continuing authority of Pomerene
10 Water Users Association to act on its own behalf and on behalf of its members. By order
11 dated July 26, 2017, the court directed the owners of land for which Arizona Department of
12 Water Resources had identified as places of use for water diverted through the Pomerene
13 Canal to file new or amended statements of claimant if they desired to assert a claim for a
14 right to divert water through the Pomerene Users Association Canal for irrigation use. A
15 second status conference was set for October 18, 2017.

17
18 At the status conference held on October 18, 2017, the newly elected board of the
19 Pomerene Water Users Association appeared along with its counsel. The court directed the
20 Pomerene Water Users Association to file a list by December 29, 2017 that identified those
21 landowners who were members by the Pomerene Water Users Association and whose
22 interests would be represented by the Pomerene Water Users Association in this adjudication
23 of water rights. The court also set a third status conference for September 6, 2018. On
24 December 21, 2017, the Pomerene Water Users Association timely filed a list of 26
25 landowners. El Dorado Benson LLC and the Kirkpatrick Family Trust were not included on
26 the list filed by Pomerene Water Users Association.

1 On August 31, 2018, Pomerene Water Users Association filed a Notice of
2 Termination. At the third status conference counsel for the Pomerene Water Users
3 Association provided a list of its members who joined the St. David Irrigation District and
4 those members who declined to join the St. David Irrigation District. El Dorado Benson LLC
5 and the Kirkpatrick Family Trust were not included on either list.

6 By order dated October 5, 2018, the cases previously consolidated into a single case
7 known as *In re Pomerene Water Users Association* were separated into individual cases.

8
9 **Landowners and Sources of Water**

10 The first step to adjudicate the potential water rights identified by the WFR is to
11 identify the current landowners involved in this case. Based on the WFR, the land involved
12 may include the following tax parcels: 124-18-008B and 124-18-008D. According to the
13 Cochise County Assessor the respective owners of those parties are the Kirkpatrick Family
14 Trust and El Dorado Benson LLC. Attached as Attachment C is map of the parcels provided
15 by the Cochise County Assessor. Based on the public records of the Arizona Department of
16 Water Resources neither landowner has filed a statement of claimant or had a statement of
17 claimant assigned to it with respect to claims for water rights for use on the land.

18
19 The stated sources of water for use on the land include in the WFR were diversions of
20 water from the San Pedro River through the Pomerene Water Users Association Canal and
21 wells. Given the termination of the Pomerene Water Users Association and the fact that the
22 lands described by the WFR have apparently not been annexed into the St. David Irrigation
23 District, wells must provide the source of water for the potential water rights.

24
25 **Status Conference**

26 An initial status conference shall be held in this case to determine if the landowners
27 intend to assert claims for the potential water rights included in the WFR. Failure to
28

1 participate at the status conference or file a statement of claimant with the Arizona Department
2 of Water Resources may result in no adjudication of the potential water rights associated with
3 the land described in the WFR. Accordingly,

4 **IT IS ORDERED** that by **May 31, 2019**, the Arizona Department of Water Resources
5 shall file a map that shows the wells identified in the WFR as sources of water for the potential
6 water rights relative to the boundaries of the subflow zone.

8 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:**

9
10 1. Contested Case. This contested case shall be known as *In re Max J. and Donna*
11 *Kartchner* and it will address the objections that were filed to the watershed file report 112-17-
12 BDA-007 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report
13 (1991). Copies of objections can be found on the following website:

14 2. Litigants. The litigants in this contested case are the claimants, the current
15 landowners, all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file reports who are listed
16 on Attachment B, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

17 3. Court-Approved Mailing List.

18 A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all
19 persons listed on Attachment B to this order. The list may be modified only by
20 filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing
21 list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
22

23 B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County
24 Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Court-
25 approved mailing list.

1 C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file
2 a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be
3 automatically added to the mailing list.

4 4. Courtesy Email List.

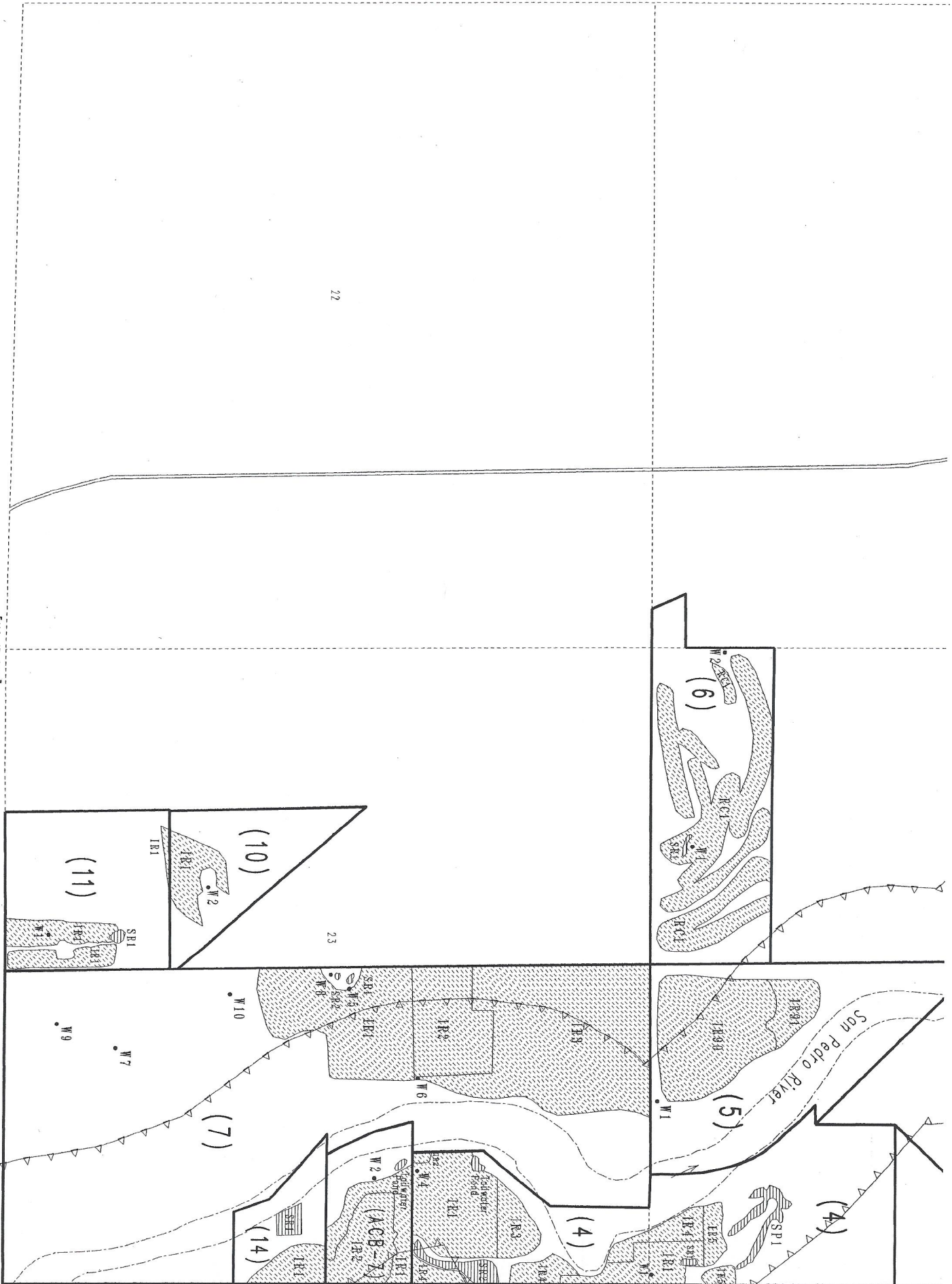

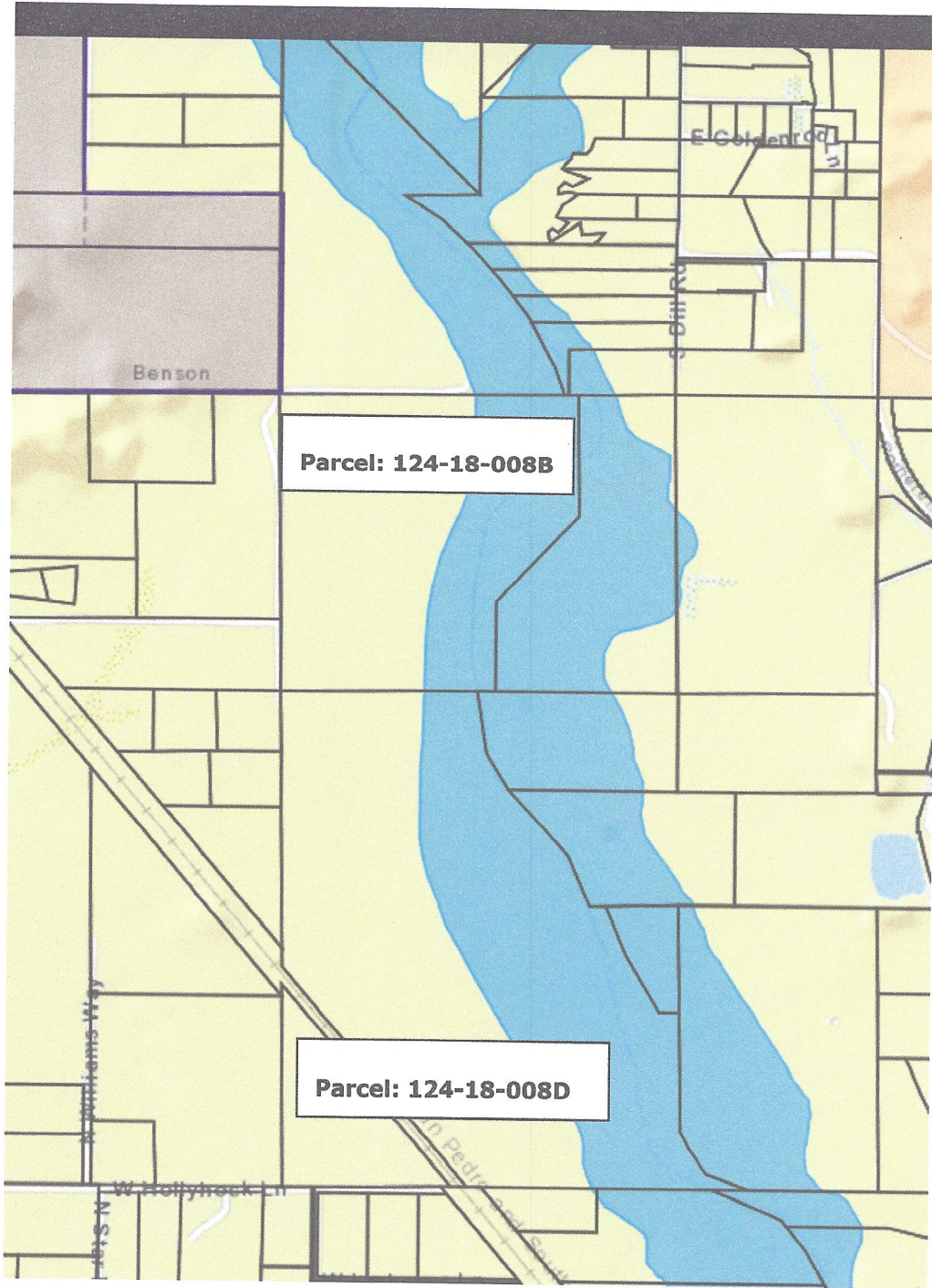
