1 **General Explanation**

2 This Order begins the process necessary to determine legal rights to water from wells
3 located on land along the San Pedro River in Cochise County. This contested case is one of the
4 many cases in the General Stream Adjudication for the San Pedro River watershed. Other cases
5 in which claims have been made to water in the San Pedro River watershed have been completed,
6 are in the process of determining water rights, or awaiting initiation.

7 The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the rights of those persons who
8 filed statement of claimants for rights to use water from the San Pedro watershed. The General
9 Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila,
10 Agua Fria and Upper Santa Cruz watersheds.

11 Persons who fail to timely file statements of claimant will forfeit any rights to the use of
12 water in the river system and source. In this case, Rex Ellsworth, Elbert Miller, and Cecil and
13 Trudy Kempton filed the original statements of claimant for the legal rights to use water on land
14 that is the subject of this case which is located in Township 14S Range 20E and Township 15S
15 Range 20E that is more specifically shown on the map attached as Attachment A. The land
16 involved in this case is labelled on Attachment A as “(AD-1)” and “(1)”.

17 The Arizona Department of Water Resources investigated the claims for water rights on
18 the land and prepared a report known as Watershed File Report 113-14-AD-001 (“WFR”)
19 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). A copy
20 of the WFR is attached as Attachment B. At the time that Arizona Department of Water
21 Resources filed the WFR, it identified the landowner as H. Clifford and Carolyn Dobson.
22 According to the public records of the Cochise County Recorder, portions of the property have
23 been transferred to successor landowners, and the Cochise County Assessor identifies the current
24 landowners as follows:

A copy of the current tax parcel map is attached as Attachment C.

The WFR identified multiple potential water rights for different types of water uses on the land. It found three potential water rights for domestic use, three potential water rights for small reservoirs, and 18 potential water rights for irrigation use. The sources of water are provided by twelve wells which ADWR has determined are located within the subflow zone of the San Pedro River.

After the Arizona Department of Water Resources issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made by the Arizona Department of Water Resources in the WFR. The purpose of this case to consider the claims made for water rights that were investigated in the WFR and resolve the objections to the WFR.

Statements of Claimant

The WFR identified seven Statements of Claimant relevant to the potential water rights which have been assigned from the original landowners to successor land owners as shown below:

1 **IT IS ORDERED:**

2 1. Contested Case. This contested case shall be known as *In re H. Clifford and*
3 *Carolyn Dobson* and it will address the Statements of Claimant listed above and the objections
4 to Watershed File Report 113-04-AD-001 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed
5 Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be found under the case name

9 2. Litigants. The litigants in this contested case are the assignees of the Statements
10 of the Claimant, the successor landowners, all persons who filed objections to the WFR who are
11 included in the list on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.
12

13 3. Court-Approved Mailing List.

14 A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all
15 persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by
16 filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list.
17 Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.

19 B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County
20 Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Court-
21 approved mailing list.

22 C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file
23 a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be
24 automatically added to the mailing list.

26 4. Courtesy Email List. The Special Master's office will email courtesy copies of
27 orders and minute entries entered in this case to persons listed on Attachment D. Requests for

3 5. Status Conference. A telephonic status conference shall be held on July 20, 2020
4 at 2:00 p.m. The purpose of the status conference is to determine if the current landowners and
5 assignees of the Statements of Claimant intend to pursue claims for water rights on the land. If
6 rights to water use will be pursued, then during the telephonic conference there will also be a
7 discussion about the identification of the correct landowner to assert the rights, any necessary
8 assignments of the filed Statements of Claimant, and the next steps in this process to adjudicate
9 claimed water rights which may involve a settlement of the objections to the Watershed File Report
10 prepared by Arizona Department of Water Resources.

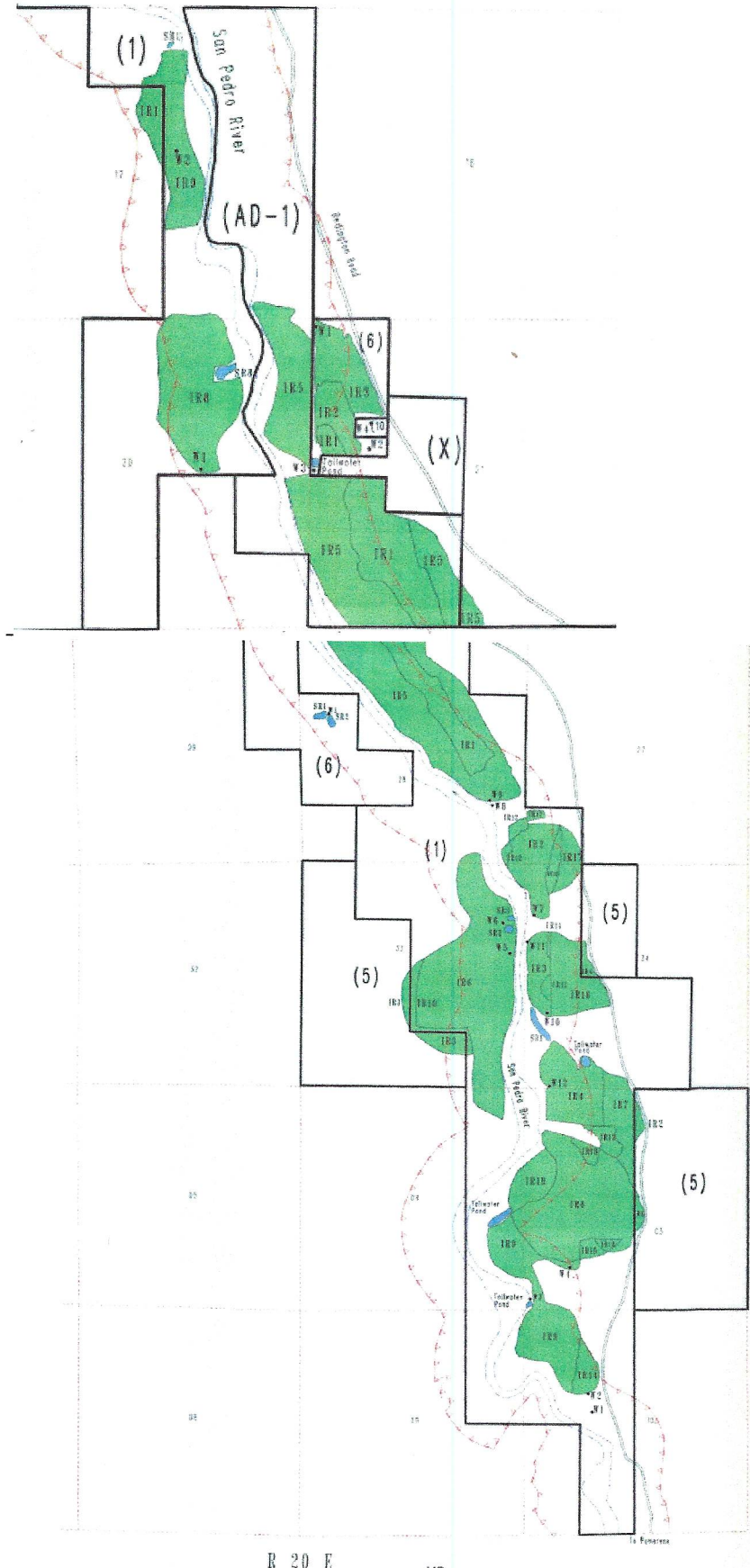

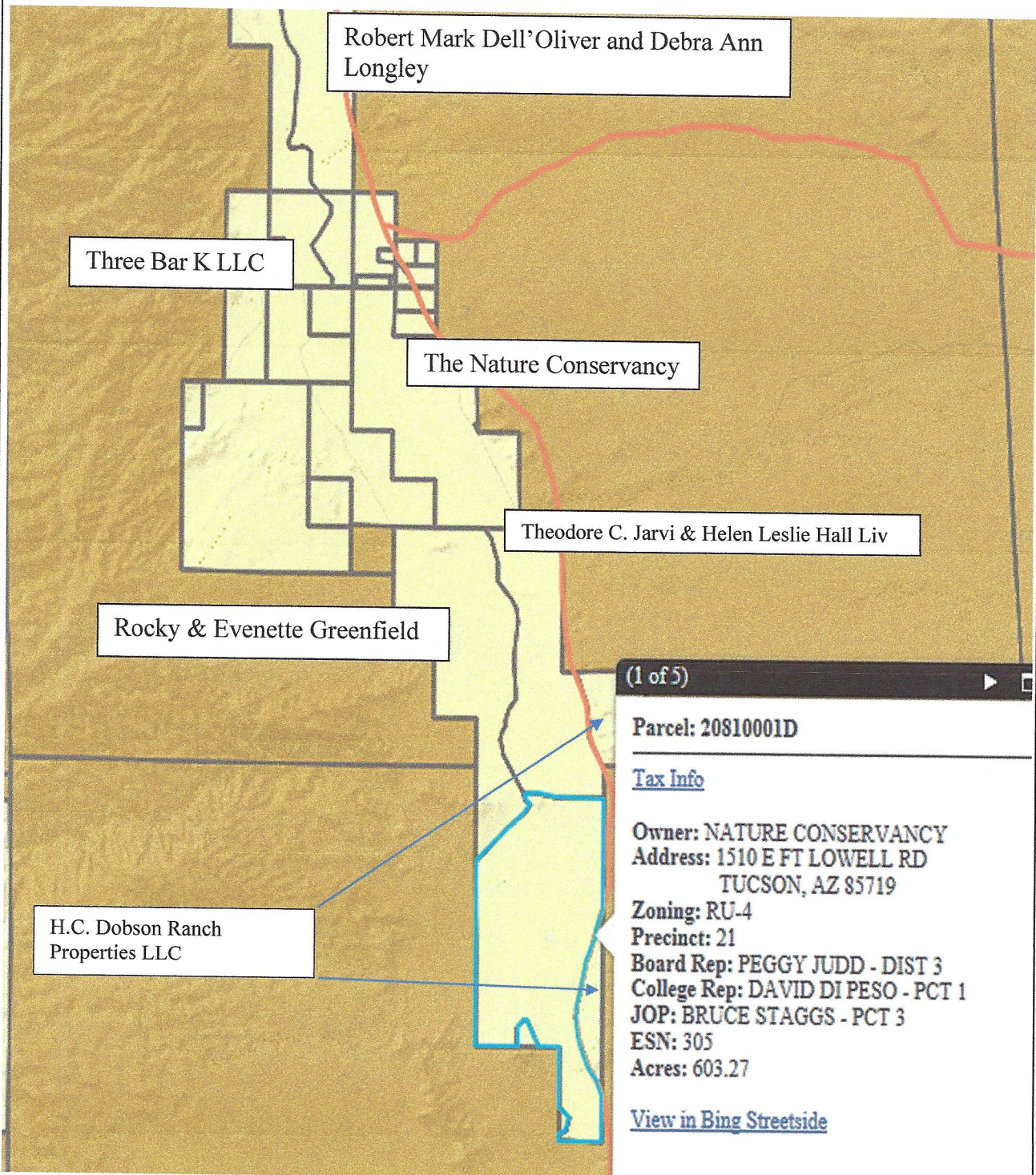
