AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE  
AMENDED STATEMENTS OF  
CLAIMANT

CONTESTED CASE NAME: *In re Asarco – Diversion*  
HSR INVOLVED: San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report.  
DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: ASARCO LLC granted a 90-day extension to file amended statements of claimant, ordered to file a preliminary report regarding potential water rights and denied a request to vacate the status conference.

1 ASARCO, LLC requests an additional 90 days to complete assignments of the  
2 statements of claimant filed by ASARCO Incorporated to ASARCO Conservation Foundation  
3 and ASARCO LLC.<sup>1</sup> A reference is also made to the need to take additional action due to a  
4 transfer of land to the United States Bureau of Reclamation, although no description is given of  
5 the land involved. ASARCO LLC further seeks additional time to gather factual information to  
6 amend its claims for water rights and to discuss possible settlement with those persons and  
7 entities that have filed objections to the potential water rights described in the Watershed File  
8 Reports. While it is important that the water rights are properly titled in the names of the  
9 correct legal entities, the process of identifying the remaining characteristics of water rights  
10 should continue while the formal title transfers and assignments are completed among the  
11 entities that appear to be related. To avoid unnecessarily delaying the settlement process or,  
12 where necessary, the identification of relevant issues that must be resolved ASARCO, LLC  
13 shall file a report explaining its preliminary objections to the potential water rights described in  
14 Watershed File Report 114-01-005 and 114-04-035 based on its extensive field and record  
15 research undertaken since July 25, 2018.

16 Accordingly,

17 **IT IS ORDERED** granting an extension of the deadline to file amended statements of  
18 claimant until April 8, 2019 and otherwise denying ASARCO LLC's motion to vacate the  
19 status conference set for February 8, 2019.

20 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that ASARCO LLC shall file with the court by January  
21 31, 2019, a report describing its preliminary objections to the potential water rights at issue in  
22 this case.
