1 On May 1, 2020, Aravaipa Farm LLC moved to stay proceedings in this case until the  
2 resolution of *In re St. David Irrigation District*, contested case no. W1-11-1675. Among the  
3 issues to be tried in *In re St. David Irrigation District* is the correct methodology to quantify the  
4 amount of appropriative water used for irrigation. Based on the representation made at the Status  
5 Conference, the parties could not reach an agreement about the quantity of water for the potential  
6 water right for irrigation use. Accordingly, based on good cause shown

8 **IT IS ORDERED:**

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10 1. Stay. Granting the request to stay proceedings in this matter until the hearing  
11 scheduled in *In re St. David Irrigation District* to determine the correct methodology to quantify  
12 the amount of appropriative water used for irrigation is concluded. Thereafter the stay shall be  
13 deemed vacated and the case shall proceed.

14 2. Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure. Except as specifically provided to the contrary  
15 in this Case Management Order, the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure shall govern all of the  
16 proceedings including time periods, page limits, permitted pleadings, form of motions, required  
17 disclosures, and discovery.

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19 3. Disclosure Statements. The parties shall file their initial Disclosure Statements by  
20 **May 3, 2021**.

21 4. Discovery. All discovery including depositions shall be completed by **October 1,**  
22 **2021**.

23 5. Prehearing Conference. A Prehearing Conference shall be held at 1:30 on **October**  
24 **14, 2021** in the Superior Court of Arizona, Central Court Building, Courtroom 301, 201 West  
25 Jefferson Street, Phoenix, AZ 85003-2202. At the Prehearing Conference, the parties shall be  
26 prepared to provide an estimate of the length of the hearing, any special requests for court facilities,  
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1 proposed dates for filing motions in limine and whether a joint pretrial statement should be  
2 required.

3 6. Dispositive Motions. On or before **October 29, 2021**, any party in this case may  
4 file a dispositive motion.
