This Order initiates a contested case to consider the claims and resolve objections to Watershed File Report 115-04-ADC-006 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The WFR identified potential water rights for domestic, irrigation, and small reservoir uses for the land described in the WFR located in sections 04 and 09 Township 7S Range 17E. The identified sources of water for the claimed uses are surface water from Aravaipa Creek and two wells. A copy of the watershed file report

is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map prepared for the WFR is attached as Attachment B, and a copy of the current tax parcel map is attached as Attachment C.

Claimants & Landowners

Joel W. Rubin filed Statement of Claimant 39-2281 (SOC) claiming a recreational and wildlife use on the land described in the WFR. The WFR named Joel William Rubin as the owner of the property described in 115-04-ADC-006. The public records maintained by Arizona Department of Water Resources do not contain an assignment of the SOC.

By Warranty Deed filed on July 21, 1999 with the Pinal County Recorder at fee number 1999-033151, Joel William Rubin conveyed 3.345 acres in section 9 T7S R17E to Frank B. Christopher. On that same date, Frank B. Christopher conveyed property in section 9 T7S R17E to Kelly G. Glenn and Sandra T. Knox. Pinal County has identified that property in section 9 as tax parcel 300-42-005D. The public records maintained by ADWR do not show that Kelly G. Glenn and Sandra T. Knox have filed a statement of claimant with respect to section 9 T7S R17E. Joel William Rubin is listed by the Pinal County Assessor as the owner of tax parcel 300-42-005C.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Joel William Rubin* and it will address the Statement of Claimant and objections that were filed regarding the watershed file report 115-04-ADC-006 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be found under the case name and number on the following website: http://www.superiorcourt.maricopa.gov/SuperiorCourt/GeneralStreamAdjudication/whatsNew.

2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the claimants, the current landowners, all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file reports who are listed on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Courtapproved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.

5. <u>Status Conference.</u> An initial status conference shall be held to address the adjudication of this case and determine whether the objections to the potential water rights can be settled. prehearing motions, and hold a trial. 
