On November 16, 2018, 42 abstracts were issued for water rights analyzed by watershed  
file reports nos. 115-05-005, 115-05-017, and 115-05-018 included in the final hydrographic  
survey report for the San Pedro Watershed ("San Pedro HSR"). On January 17, 2019, Salt  
River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District and Salt River Valley Water Users'

3 (ADWR). Specifically, Salt River Project requested that ADWR provided additional
