Ms. Magoffin reports that she has received approval of proposed abstracts for irrigation uses from all parties except the United States and the Tonto Apache Tribe. Mr. Barry states that he has not yet gotten client approval of the proposed stipulation but will respond by **May 28, 2021**. Ms. Mulhern states that the Tonto Apache Tribe is prepared to sign off on the stipulation.

The Court notes that it has received suggested corrections from SRP and the San Carlos Apache Tribe to the proposed abstract circulated to all of the parties.
