Pursuant to the Case Management Order in this case, Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) will schedule a meeting with the current landowners, as successors in interest to Mr. and Mrs. Bowers, and the objectors no later than May 4, 2018. At the conclusion of the meeting, ADWR shall file a Meeting Report pursuant to Rules for Proceeding Before the Special Master, §8.02[1][c]. The Meeting Report shall contain as an attachment a

written statement from any objector who raises an issue at the meeting regarding the current landowner's title to the property identified in Watershed File Report 115-04-ADB-009 or to the chain of title from the original appropriator of the water used on the land to the current landowner.

The doctrine of prior appropriation under Arizona law treats a water right as appurtenant to, although severable under limited circumstances, from the land on which it is to be used. A.R.S. §45-172. *See also Salt River Valley. Water Users' Ass'n v. Kovacovich*, 3 Ariz. App. 28, 30, 411 P.2d 201, 203 (1966); *Gillespie Land & Irr. Co., v. Buckeye Irr. Co.*, 75 Ariz. 377, 257 P. 2d 393 (1953). The general rule is that "[w]hen the water right . . . is appurtenant to the land, a conveyance of the land, without more, transfers the appurtenant water right." 1 *Waters and Water Rights* §12.02(f) (Amy K. Kelley, ed., 3<sup>rd</sup> ed. LexisNexis/Matthew Bender 2018). The objector shall provide to ADWR within two business days of the meeting a written statement in support of the objector's position.
