Discussion is held regarding LCR Coalition's Exhibit # 963 that was received in evidence yesterday, January 27, 2021, and LCR Coalition's Exhibit 110.

For the reasons stated on the record,

LCR Coalition's Exhibit #110 is received in evidence, and is substituted for LCR Coalition's Exhibit #963. LCR Coalition's Exhibit #963 is not received in evidence.

Discussion is held regarding LCR Coalition's Exhibits #72, LCR #1457, LCR #1456, and LCR #1458 which were offered January 27, 2021. Mr. Heiserman states that he is awaiting word from Mr. Campbell about the land descriptions in the aforementioned exhibits.

Mr. Campbell states that he is trying to find documents regarding the legal descriptions of the Hopi Partition Lands. The parties stipulate that this matter will be taken up on February 3, 2021.

Discussion is held regarding LCR Coalition's Exhibits #965 and #966 (learned treatises). Mr. Pew states that Mr. Heiserman is still reviewing the documents and requests that discussion on these exhibits be taken up on February 3, 2021, as well.

Mr. Leonard states that Hopi Exhibit #4393 and LCRC's Exhibit #965 are essentially the same exhibit and Hopi Exhibit # 4394 and LCRC's Exhibit #966 are essentially the same exhibit. Mr. Leonard continues to assert the hearsay objections as to the document.

Mr. Leonard will review the exhibits and highlight the portions that are acceptable to the Navajo Nation. Discussion will be held on this issue on February 3, 2021.
