22 Arguments in Phase II in the *In re Navajo Nation* contested case, and good cause appearing:


23 IT IS ORDERED that:

- 24 1. Dispositive motions related to the geographic extent of the Navajo  
25 Reservation within the Arizona portion of the Little Colorado River  
Basin will be filed in Phase II of this contested case;

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2. Rulings on dispositive motions addressing the geographic extent of the Navajo Reservation within the Arizona portion of the Little Colorado River Basin may be applied to any claim asserted in this contested case regardless of the phase in which the claim is asserted, including to claims for DCMI, stock and wildlife watering, and stockpond uses, or to stipulations to the attributes for such claims (with the caveat that the quantity attribute for livestock and wildlife watering shall not be reduced from 3000 AFA); and
3. Parties may develop evidence, including witness testimony and documentary evidence, related to the geographic extent of the Navajo Reservation within the Arizona portion of the Little Colorado River Basin in any phase of this contested case up to the close of discovery in Phase II.
