The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated the claims made by the LDS Church ("Claimant") and prepared Watershed File Report ("WFR") 33-51-008, published in the Final Silver Creek Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991) ("Silver Creek HSR"). The WFR recorded that water was being used for five stockponds within sections 8, 13, 14, and 23 of Township 12 North, Range 21 East. A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment B. A copy of a map, prepared by ADWR, showing the investigation area is attached as Attachment C.

After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR by the Salt River Project and the United States joined by the Navajo Nation, the Hopi Tribe, and the San Juan Southern Paiute Tribe. The purpose of this case is to consider the claims in the SOCs mentioned above and to resolve the objections to WFR No. 33-51-008.

Claimant and Landowners

website, the land investigated appears to comprise eleven Navajo County tax parcels. A copy of the map showing the relevant tax parcels and a table stating current ownership is attached as Attachment D. The public records of ADWR do not contain any assignments of the SOCs listed in the WFRs, and landowners do not appear to have filed

any additional SOCs since the issuance of the 1991 HSR.

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Objections

Objections to WFR 33-51-008 were primarily related to the discrepancies between priority dates claimed in SOCs and those claimed in stockpond registration filings and statements of claim.

WFR 33-51-008 lists the LDS Church as the owner of the property investigated

Additionally, in order to obtain a decreed water right, a property owner must present to the Court both an SOC claiming a water right in the name of the property owner and the evidence of that right. Further, the property owner must ensure that all water rights claims are paired with the appropriate basis of right, e.g. a statement of claim, decree, stockpond registration, or water right certificate... Alternatively, the property owners may settle with objectors. If either the property owner proves to the Court the existence of a water right on their property or enters into a valid settlement approved by the Court, the court will recognize enforceable water rights in a "Final Decree." Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-257(B).

This is an order from the Court, and all parties must comply with the following instructions. The failure to obey this, or any, court order may result in the dismissal of this case and the loss of potential surface water rights. 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IT IS ORDERED:

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- 1. Case Initiation. This order initiates contested case *In re Church of Jesus* Christ – LDS. This case will resolve claims to use appropriable water asserted in Statements of Claimant 39-81392-94, 39-81397-99, 39-81402, and 39-88519 and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report No. 33-51-008.
- 2. Initial Conference. An initial conference shall be held on Wednesday, September 18, 2024, at 9:30 a.m. to determine whether each current landowner intends to pursue claims for water rights. The conference will be held using the Court Connect program. Instructions for Court Connect are attached as Attachment E. If you receive this Order by email, click on the red box "Join Court Connect Hearing" on the attached instructions to make an appearance. If you do not receive this Order by email, log into the Court Connect program the internet by typing on https://tinyurl.com/specialwatermaster. If you do not have access to the internet, you may attend telephonically using the telephone number and access code included in the instructions for Court Connect.
- 3. Parties. The litigants in this contested case are the claimant, the current landowners, and all parties who filed objections to the Watershed File Report. The objectors are the Salt River Project, the United States, the San Juan Southern Paiute Tribe, the Hopi Tribe, and the Navajo Nation.
- 4. Objections. Copies of objections filed to this case can be found under the respective names and numbers the following website: on

5. Court-Approved Mailing List.

<u>ATTACHMENT A</u>

General Background on the Water Rights Determination Process in Arizona

A general stream adjudication is a judicial proceeding to determine the quantity and priority of all water rights in a river system. Arizona is undertaking general stream adjudications of both the Gila River and the Little Colorado River systems. A river system includes surface water flowing "in streams or other natural channels", groundwater sufficiently connected to that surface water, and water subject to claims by the federal government. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-251(7). Recognizing and respecting water rights and the priority of such rights is important in Arizona where times of drought or water scarcity can occur.

All cases begin with the filing of a "Statement of Claimant," ("SOC") in which a property owner makes a claim for a right to use surface water on their property. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-254(A). This person is the "claimant." The SOCs contain, among other characteristics, a description of the source and quantity of the water used, the location of use, the location from which the water was diverted, and the date when the water was first put to use. *Id.* § 45-254(C).

After the property owner files the SOCs, the Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") prepares a "Watershed File Report," ("WFR") in which ADWR investigates the claims in the SOCs and recommends water rights associated with the property. *Id.* § 45-256(B). ADWR compiles all WFRs for a watershed into a comprehensive Hydrographic Survey Report ("HSR") and publishes the report for public review and comment. In response, other claimants in the Adjudication may file "objections" disputing the information or recommendations in the WFR. The individuals who file objections are called "objectors."

This "contested case", one of thousands in the Little Colorado River System, will evaluate claims asserted in specific Statements of Claimant while considering objections to the WFR that reported ADWR's initial inspection of those claims.




