Initial conference set for March 5, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. 19 NUMBER OF PAGES: 14 20 21 **General Explanation** 22 This order opens a case to determine rights to use water on land that the Navajo County 23 Assessor has identified as owned by Stephen and Stephanie Peterson, David R. Peterson, Jon 24 and Laurie Cato, and Jack G. Peterson. The first step in this case is an initial conference with the 25 Court, scheduled for March 5, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. to determine if landowners are interested 26 in pursuing potential water rights. Interested Parties MUST attend the scheduled initial

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conference if they plan to pursue potential water rights. Failure to appear at the initial conference could result in the dismissal of the case and the loss of water rights associated with the properties.

In this case, Jack G. Peterson and Victor Scott Peterson filed Statements of Claimant ("SOCs") 39-86831 and 39-86832 on June 27, 1985, to assert claims to use water on land that appears to include Navajo County tax parcels 212-26-205A, 212-26-208G, 212-26-141C, 212-26-141F, 212-26-141G, 212-26-141D, and 212-26-141E. Ownership of these parcels is described by this table:

The first step in this case will be an initial conference, where landowners will state whether they intend to pursue water rights.

Additional background information on the process for determining water rights in Arizona can be found on Attachment A.

Details of the Case

On June 27, 1985, Jack G. Peterson and Victor Scott Peterson filed Statements of Claimant ("SOCs") 39-86831 and 39-86832. On April 18, 2013, Ralph Eggleston filed SOC 39-95185. The SOCs contain the following claims:

The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated the claims made by Jack G. Peterson and Victor Scott Peterson ("Claimants") and prepared Watershed File Report No. 33-56-060 ("WFR"), published in the Final Silver Creek Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991) ("Silver Creek HSR"). The WFR recorded that water was being used for a stockpond within the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 24, Township 9 North, Range 22 East. A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment B.

After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR by the United States, the Arizona State Land Department, and Blanche, Victor, Jack, and Karen Peterson. The Hopi Tribe, Navajo Nation, and San Juan Southern Paiute Tribe joined in the United States's objections. The purpose of this case is to consider the claims made for water rights in SOCs 39-86831, 39-86832, 39-95185 and to resolve the objections to WFR 33-56-060.

Claimant and Landowners

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The WFR lists Victor Scott and Blanche Peterson and Jack G. and Karen Peterson as the owners of the property described as located in NENENW Section 24, T9N R22E in 1991 when the WFR was completed. According to maps obtained from the Navajo County Assessor ("Assessor") and documents obtained from the Navajo County Recorder, the land investigated appears to comprise Navajo County tax parcels 212-26-141D, 212-26-141E, 212-26-141G, 212-26-141F, 212-26-141C, 212-26-208G, and 212-26-205A.

Attachment C contains a description for each parcel of the relevant documents obtained from the Navajo County Recorder. A copy of the map on file with the Assessor showing the relevant tax parcels and current ownership is attached as Attachment D.

The public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not contain any assignments of the SOC listed in the WFR, and the current landowners do not appear to have filed any additional SOCs.

Property owners must file Statements of Claimant and present to the Court evidence that water rights are attached to their property and have been legally claimed or transferred to them. This evidence may include the WFR. Alternatively, the property owners may settle with objectors. If either the property owners prove to the Court the existence of water rights on their properties or enter into a valid settlement approved by the Court, the court will recognize enforceable water rights in a "Final Decree." Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-257(B).

This is an order from the court and all parties must comply with the following instructions. The failure to obey this, or any, court order may result in the dismissal of this case and the loss of any potential water rights associated with the properties mentioned in this order. If you have questions regarding this Order or any of the attachments, please contact the General Stream Adjudication, Office of the Special Water Master, at (602) 372-4115. Please note that staff can only answer administrative questions and cannot provide legal advice.

IT IS ORDERED:

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1. <u>Case Initiation.</u> This contested case shall be known as *In re V.S. and Blanche Peterson*, and it will partially resolve claims to appropriable water asserted in Statements of Claimant 39-86831 and 39-86832 and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report No. 33-56-060. - 2. Initial Conference. An initial conference shall be held on March 5, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. to determine whether current landowners intend to pursue claims for water rights. The conference will be held using the Court Connect program. Instructions for Court Connect are attached as Attachment F. If you receive this Order by email, click on the red box "Join Court Connect Hearing" on the attached instructions to make an appearance. If you do not receive this Order by email, log the Court into Connect program on the internet typing https://tinyurl.com/specialwatermaster. If you do not have access to the internet, you may attend telephonically using the telephone number and access code included in the instructions for Court Connect.
- 3. <u>Parties</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, the current landowners, and all parties who filed objections to the Watershed File Report. The objectors in this case are the United States, the Arizona State Land Department, and Blanche, Victor, Jack, and Karen Peterson, as well as the Hopi Tribe, the Navajo Nation, and San Juan Southern Paiute Tribe.

- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Apache County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Court will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list.

ATTACHMENT A

General Background on the Water Rights Determination Process in Arizona

A general stream adjudication is a judicial proceeding to determine the quantity and priority of all water rights in a river system. Arizona is undertaking general stream adjudications of both the Gila River and the Little Colorado River systems. A river system includes surface water flowing "in streams or other natural channels", groundwater sufficiently connected to that surface water, and water subject to claims by the federal government. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-251(7). Recognizing and respecting water rights and the priority of such rights is important in Arizona where times of drought or water scarcity can occur.

All cases begin with the filing of a "Statement of Claimant," ("SOC") in which a property owner makes a claim for a right to use surface water on their property. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-254(A). This person is the "claimant." The SOCs contain, among other characteristics, a description of the source and quantity of the water used, the location of use, the location from which the water was diverted, and the date when the water was first put to use. *Id.* § 45-254(C).

After the property owner files the SOCs, the Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") prepares a "Watershed File Report," ("WFR") in which ADWR investigates the claims in the SOCs and recommends water rights associated with the property. *Id.* § 45-256(B). ADWR compiles all WFRs for a watershed into a comprehensive Hydrographic Survey Report ("HSR") and publishes the report for public review and comment. In response, other claimants in the Adjudication may file "objections" disputing the information or recommendations in the WFR. The individuals who file objections are called "objectors."

This "contested case", one of thousands in the Little Colorado River System, will evaluate claims asserted in specific Statements of Claimant while considering objections to the WFR that reported ADWR's initial inspection of those claims.


