**General Explanation**

This order resumes, after a lengthy pause in adjudication, a case to determine rights to use water on land that the Navajo County Assessor has identified as owned by Porter Springs LLC. The first step in this case is an initial conference with the Court,

1 scheduled for **Thursday, September 19, 2024, at 9:30 a.m.** to determine if the  
2 landowner is interested in pursuing water rights claims. The current landowner **MUST**  
3 attend the scheduled initial conference if they plan to pursue a water rights claim. Failure  
4 to appear at the initial conference could result in the dismissal of the case and the loss of  
5 potential surface water rights associated with the property.

6 In this case, the United States Forest Service (“Claimant”) filed Statements of  
7 Claimant (“SOCs”) 39-80946, 39-89960, 39-91644, and 39-91860 in 1985 to assert  
8 claims to use water on land that appears to comprise Navajo County tax parcel 311-20-  
9 006, which is currently owned by Porter Springs LLC.

10 During the initial conference, the landowner must state whether they intend to  
11 pursue a water rights claim.

12  
13 **Additional background information on the process for determining water rights**  
14 **in Arizona can be found on Attachment A.**

15  
16 **Details of the Case**

17 The SOC's include claims for domestic, stockpond, stock watering, irrigation,  
18 recreational, and wildlife uses.

19 The Arizona Department of Water Resources (“ADWR”) investigated the claims  
20 and prepared Watershed File Report (“WFR”) 33-56-ADBB-001, published in the Final  
21 Silver Creek Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991) (“Silver Creek HSR”). The  
22 WFR recorded that water was supplying a domestic and stock watering use as well one  
23 stockpond and five other reservoirs within Section 18, Township 9 North Range 23 East.  
24 A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment B. A copy of a map displaying the area  
25 investigated by ADWR, denoted by “(1),” is attached as Attachment C.

26 After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the  
27 WFR by the Apache-Sitgreaves National Forest, Salt River Project and the United States  
28

1 joined by the Navajo Nation, the Hopi Tribe, and the San Juan Southern Paiute Tribe.  
2 The purpose of this case is to consider claims in SOCs 39-80946, 39-89960, 39-91644,  
3 and 39-91860 and to resolve the objections to WFR No. 33-56-ADBB-001.

#### 4 **Claimant and Landowners**

5 WFR 33-56-ADBB-001 lists “Evans, et al” as the owners of the property  
6 investigated in 1991. According to maps obtained from the Navajo County Assessor’s  
7 (“Assessor”) website, the land investigated appears to comprise Navajo County tax  
8 parcel 311-20-006, which is currently owned by Porter Springs LLC.

9 A copy of the map showing the relevant tax parcels and current ownership is  
10 attached as Attachment D. The public records of ADWR do not contain any assignments  
11 of the SOCs listed in the WFRs, and landowners do not appear to have filed any  
12 additional SOCs since the issuance of the 1991 HSR.

#### 13 **Objections**

14 There are significant objections to WFR 33-56-ADBB-001 and the property  
15 owners are encouraged to review the comments at the link below prior to the initial status  
16 conference. [http://www.superiorcourt.maricopa.gov/SuperiorCourt/GeneralStrea](http://www.superiorcourt.maricopa.gov/SuperiorCourt/GeneralStreamAdjudication/whatsNew.asp)  
17 [mAdjudication/whatsNew.asp](http://www.superiorcourt.maricopa.gov/SuperiorCourt/GeneralStreamAdjudication/whatsNew.asp).

18 In order to obtain a decreed water right, a property owner must present to the  
19 Court both an appropriate SOC claiming a water right in the name of the property owner,  
20 and evidence of that right. This evidence may include the relevant WFRs. Alternatively,  
21 the property owners may settle with objectors. If either the property owner proves to the  
22 Court the existence of a water right on their property or enters into a valid settlement  
23 approved by the Court, the court will recognize enforceable water rights in a “Final  
24 Decree.” Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-257(B).

25 This is an order from the Court, and all parties must comply with the following  
26 instructions. The failure to obey this, or any, court order may result in the dismissal of  
27 this case and the loss of potential surface water rights. If you have questions regarding  
28

1 this Order or any of the attachments, please contact the General Stream Adjudication,  
2 Office of the Special Water Master, at (602) 372-4115. Please note that staff can only  
3 answer administrative questions and cannot provide legal advice.

4 **IT IS ORDERED:**

5 1. Case Initiation. This order initiates contested case CV6417-33-7056.

6 This case will resolve claims to use appropriable water asserted in  
7 Statements of Claimant 39-80946, 39-89960, 39-91644, and 39-91860 and  
8 objections that were filed to Watershed File Report No. 33-56-ADBB-001.

9 2. Initial Conference. An initial conference shall be held on **Thursday,**  
10 **September 19, 2024, at 9:30 a.m.** to determine whether the current  
11 landowner intends to pursue claims for water rights. The conference will be  
12 held using the Court Connect program. Instructions for Court Connect are  
13 attached as Attachment E. If you receive this Order by email, click on the red  
14 box “Join Court Connect Hearing” on the attached instructions to make an  
15 appearance. If you do not receive this Order by email, log into the Court  
16 Connect program on the internet by typing  
17 <https://tinyurl.com/specialwatermaster>. If you do not have access to the  
18 internet, you may attend telephonically using the telephone number and access  
19 code included in the instructions for Court Connect.

20 3. Parties. The litigants in this contested case are the claimant, the current  
21 landowner, and all parties who filed objections to the Watershed File Report.  
22 The objectors are Apache-Sitgreaves National Forest, Salt River Project, the  
23 United States, the San Juan Southern Paiute Tribe, the Hopi Tribe, and the  
24 Navajo Nation.

14 intervene will be automatically added to the Court-approved  
15 mailing list.

16 D. The Clerk of the Court will send copies of all minute entries and  
17 orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved

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

**ATTACHMENT A**

**General Background on the Water Rights Determination Process in Arizona**

A general stream adjudication is a judicial proceeding to determine the quantity and priority of all water rights in a river system. Arizona is undertaking general stream adjudications of both the Gila River and the Little Colorado River systems. A river system includes surface water flowing “in streams or other natural channels”, groundwater sufficiently connected to that surface water, and water subject to claims by the federal government. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-251(7). Recognizing and respecting water rights and the priority of such rights is important in Arizona where times of drought or water scarcity can occur.

All cases begin with the filing of a “Statement of Claimant,” (“SOC”) in which a property owner makes a claim for a right to use surface water on their property. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-254(A). This person is the “claimant.” The SOCs contain, among other characteristics, a description of the source and quantity of the water used, the location of use, the location from which the water was diverted, and the date when the water was first put to use. *Id.* § 45-254(C).

After the property owner files the SOCs, the Arizona Department of Water Resources (“ADWR”) prepares a “Watershed File Report,” (“WFR”) in which ADWR investigates the claims in the SOCs and recommends water rights associated with the property. *Id.* § 45-256(B). ADWR compiles all WFRs for a watershed into a comprehensive Hydrographic Survey Report (“HSR”) and publishes the report for public review and comment. In response, other claimants in the Adjudication may file “objections” disputing the information or recommendations in the WFR. The individuals who file objections are called “objectors.”

This “contested case”, one of thousands in the Little Colorado River System, will evaluate claims asserted in specific Statements of Claimant while considering objections to the WFR that reported ADWR’s initial inspection of those claims.

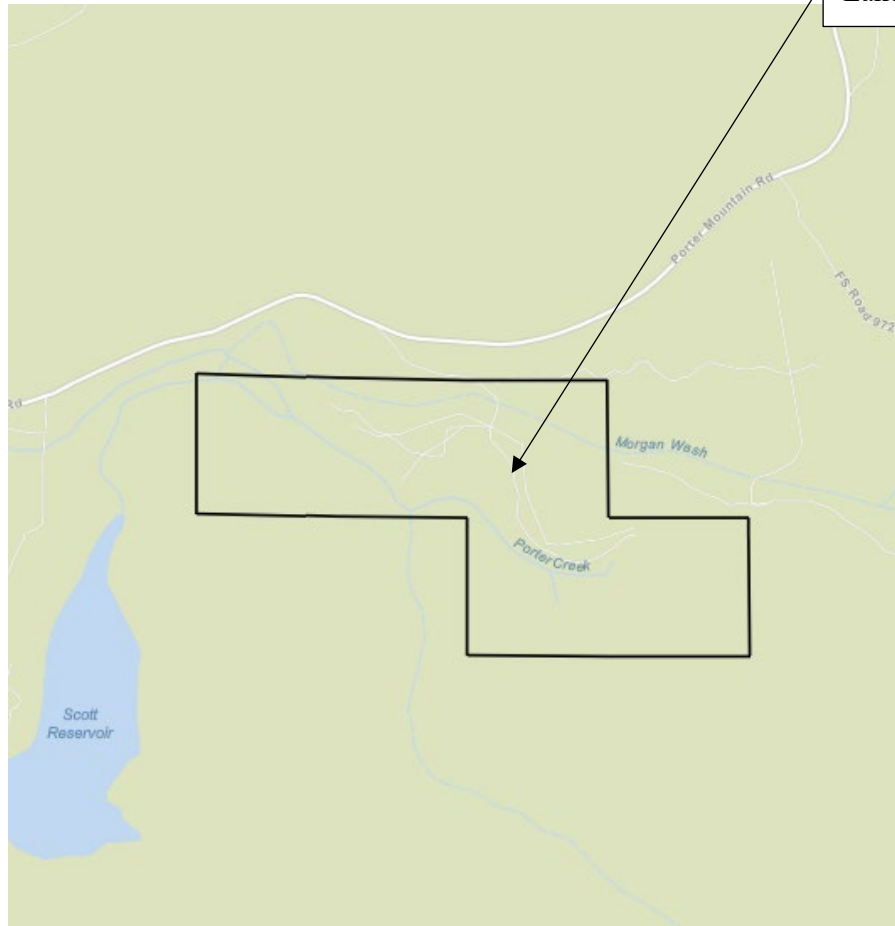
