DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: The Hopi Tribe and the United States are granted leave to file a response to the Joinder filed by the City of Flagstaff to the Navajo Nation's Motion to Strike.



DATE OF FILING: July 25, 2018

On July 24, 2018, the City of Flagstaff filed a joinder to the Navajo Nation's Motion to Strike, filed June 23, 2018. The Hopi Tribe moved to either strike the Joinder filed by the City of

1 Flagstaff or be given an opportunity to file a response limited to only new arguments raised by the
2 City of Flagstaff. The Hopi Tribe's Motion to Strike is denied because the City of Flagstaff did
3 request in open court and was granted a very short time period to file a joinder setting forth its
4 position with respect to the Navajo Nation's Motion to Strike a portion of the Hopi Tribe's and
5 United States' 5th Amended Statements of Claimant, which were filed after the extended
6 discovery period had terminated. The Hopi Tribe's alternative request, however, is granted.
7

8 **IT IS ORDERED** that the Hopi Tribe and the United States, if it desires, may file a
9 response to the Joinder filed by the City of Flagstaff that will be limited to the new arguments
10 raised in the Joinder. The response shall be filed by July 30, 2018.
