In a Minute Entry issued in this case on October 11, 2021, the Court ordered that Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") file a map defining the relationship of the well registered under Brandy Harper and Brandon Miller, registration no. 55-601393, and the subflow zone. The Minute Entry stated that if the well was located outside the boundaries of the subflow zone and Brandon Miller had filed a Statement of Claimant, the Court would stay this case until ADWR competes the subflow depletion test.

On November 2, 2021, ADWR filed a map that confirms the well is outside of the subflow zone. Additionally, Brandy Harper and Brandon Miller have filed a Statement of Claimant with ADWR for this potential water right. Accordingly, the determination of any such right must be stayed until the approval of the subflow depletion test.

IT IS ORDERED that this case is stayed
