General Explanation

This Order begins the process necessary to adjudicate claims made for rights to appropriate water for use on land the Cochise County Assessor identified as owned by Kathryn P. Ingram. This contested case is one of the many cases in the Arizona General Stream Adjudication for the San Pedro River Watershed to determine legal rights to water. Other cases

1 in which claims have been made for legal rights to water in the San Pedro River Watershed have
2 been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or are awaiting initiation. The
3 purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the rights of those persons who filed
4 Statements of Claimant for rights to use appropriable water in Arizona. The General
5 Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila,
6 Agua Fria, and Upper Santa Cruz watersheds.

7 In this case, Max J. Kartchner (“Claimant”) filed Statement of Claimant (“SOC”) 39-
8 3879 on July 13, 1980 for rights to water for use on land in the northeast quarter of the northeast
9 quarter of Section 33 Township 16S Range 20E. The Arizona Department of Water Resources
10 (“ADWR”) investigated the claim, which it characterized as a claim for irrigation use, and
11 prepared a report known as Watershed File Report No. 112-17-BA-052 (“WFR”) published in
12 the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). A copy of the WFR
13 is attached as Attachment A.

14 The SOC claims water supplied by a well located NENE Section 33 T16S R20E for 200
15 acre-feet annually of water for irrigation use with a priority date of 1898. The WFR found no
16 irrigation use on the land described in the WFR. After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were
17 filed to the findings made in the WFR. The purpose of this case is to consider the claims made
18 for water rights that are the subject of the WFR and resolve the objections to the WFR. The
19 public records of ADWR do not show an assignment of the SOC to successor landowners.
20

21 **Claimant & Landowners**

22
23 The WFR identified one SOC relevant to the potential water right: 39-3879. Max J.
24 Kartchner filed the SOC claiming water for irrigation use. The WFR lists Thomas and Lynn
25 Farnsworth as the owners of the property described as located in the northeast quarter of the
26 northeast quarter of Section 33 Township 16S Range 20E. The records of the Cochise County
27 Recorder indicate that Thomas and Lynn Farnsworth conveyed the property by warranty deed to
28 Kathryn P. Ingram, recorded as document no. 1996-24485 on September 12, 1996. The public

1 records of the Cochise County Assessor list the property as tax parcel no. 208-39-009. A copy
2 of the map prepared by the Cochise County Assessor showing tax parcel no. 208-39-009 is
3 included as Attachment B.

4
5 **IT IS ORDERED:**

6 1. Contested Case. This contested case shall be known as *In re Thomas and Lynn*
7 *Farnsworth* and it will determine appropriable water rights asserted in the Statement of Claimant
8 and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report 112-17-BA-052 published in the Final
9 San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be
10 found under the case name and number on the following website:

13 2. Litigants. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, the current
14 landowner, all persons who filed objections to the WFR, and parties who are allowed to intervene
15 by order.

16 3. Court-Approved Mailing List.

17 A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all
18 persons listed on Attachment C to this order. The list may be modified
19 only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-
20 approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current
21 Court-approved mailing list.
22

23 B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County
24 Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the
25 Court-approved mailing list.

1 C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file
2 a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be
3 automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.

4 D. The Clerk of the Court will send copies of all minute entries and orders
5 issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list.
6 Upon request, the Clerk of the Court will provide copies by email. Parties
7 may request emailed copies of minute entries and orders by completing
8 and submitting a CONSENT FOR ELECTRONIC RECEIPT OF WATER
9 CASE DOCUMENTS, which is attached as Attachment D.


11 4. Status Conference. An initial status conference shall be held to determine
12 whether the Claimant or the current landowner, Kathryn P. Ingram, intend to pursue claims for
13 rights to appropriable water for irrigation use. If no person claiming a water right appears at the
14 Status Conference, then Statement of Claimant 39-3879 and this case will be dismissed and no
15 further action will be taken with respect to the WFR or the objections filed to the WFR.
16

17 The Status Conference shall be held on **March 17, 2022 at 2:10 p.m.** The Status
18 Conference shall be held using the Court Connect program. Instructions for Court Connect are
19 attached as Attachment E. If you receive this Order by email, click on the red box “Join Court
20 Connect Hearing” on the attached instructions to make an appearance. If you do not receive this

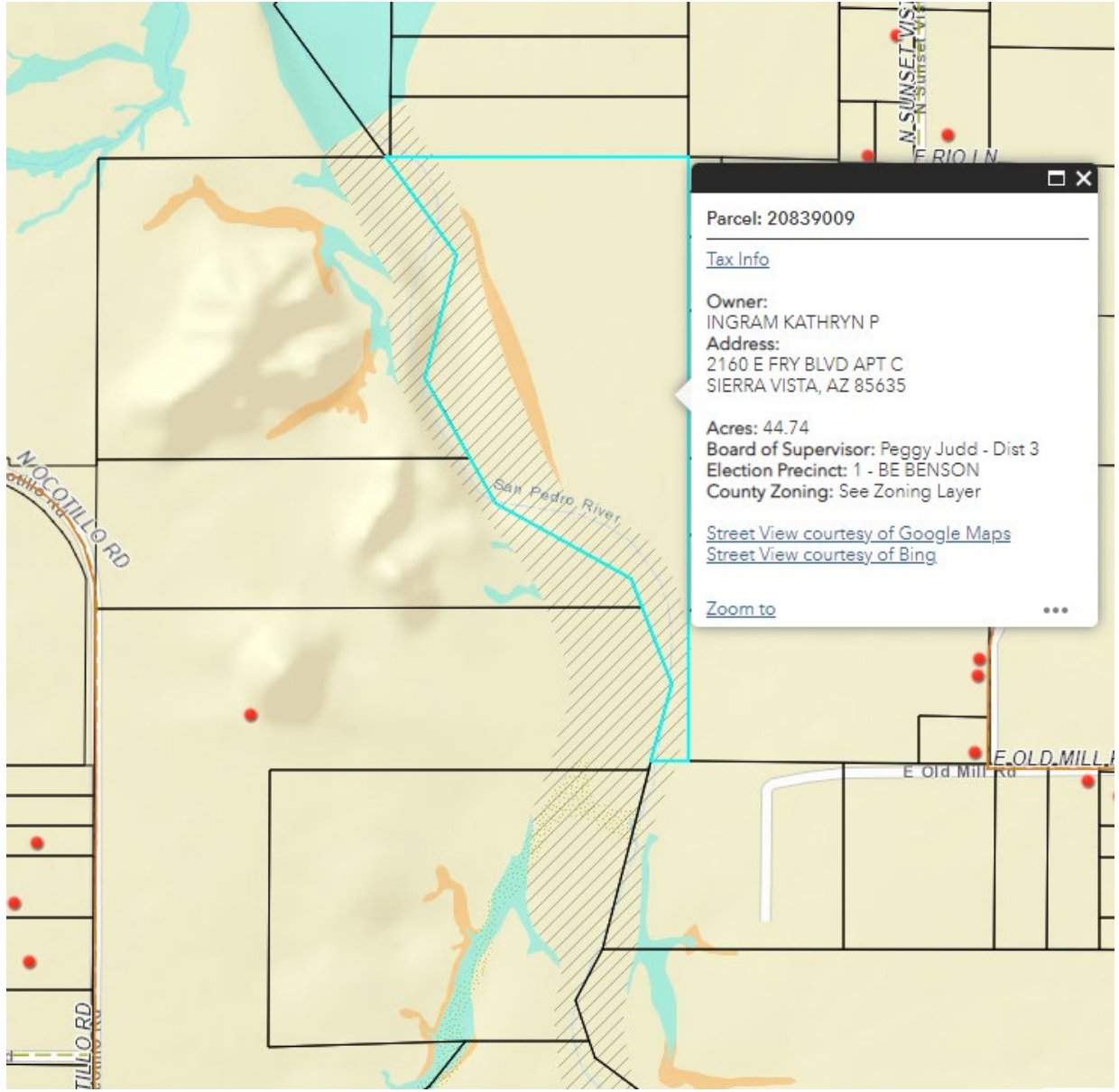
