ORDER TO ADWR TO PREPARE MAP AND SET STATUS CONFERENCE

CONTESTED CASE NAME: In re Thurber and Louise Larson

HSR INVOLVED: San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report.

DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: Order to ADWR to prepare a map and report and telephonie status conference set for landowners and objectors for March 7, 2019.

This case involves proposed water rights for an irrigation use in the NESW 11 T17S R20E identified in Watershed File Report 112-17-BAD-021 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). A copy of the Watershed File Report 112-17-BAD-021 ("WFR") is attached as Attachment A. The WFR listed the sources of water as a well and a diversion from the San Pedro River into the Pomerene Water Users Association

12327001R. According to the Cochise County Treasurer's Office the respective owners of those parties are Beverly and Thomas Wing, Gail and Renita Larson, Philip Earl Larson, Robert and Sherrie Bernal, Beverly and Thomas Wing, and Marie and Nolan Larson. Attached as Attachment B is map of the parcels from the Cochise County Assessor's Office.

The first step in this process will be to identify the land and the landowners for whom ADWR has determined potential water rights. Once ADWR has completed that step, the next step will be to a schedule a status conference to appropriately consolidate those proposed water right claims for Gail and Renita Larson and Beverly and Thomas Wing with *In re St. David Irrigation District* and to determine whether the remaining landowners intend to pursue claims for any potential water right that ADWR may determine are applicable to their land. Failure to participate at the status conference or file a statement of claimant with the Arizona Department of Water Resources may result in no adjudication of the potential water rights associated with the land described in the WFR. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that by February 15, 2019, the Arizona Department of Water Resources shall file a map and report that:

- 1. Identifies the tax parcels included in the WFR for which it found a proposed irrigation water right; and,
- 2. Locates the well referenced in the WFR relative to the boundaries of the subflow zone.

interests would be represented by the Pomerene Water Users Association in this adjudication of water rights. The court also set a third status conference for September 6, 2018. A copy of the order was sent to Robert and Sherrie Bernal, Gail and Renita Larson, Marie and Nolan Larson, Philip Earl Larson, and Beverly and Thomas Wing. On December 21, 2017, the Pomerene Water Users Association timely filed a list of 26 landowners. Gail and Renita Larson, Philip Earl Larson, and Beverly and Thomas Wing were included in the list of the represented landowners.

On August 31, 2018, Pomerene Water Users Association filed a Notice of Termination. At the third status conference, counsel for the Pomerene Water Users Association provided a list of its members who joined the St. David Irrigation District and those members who declined to join the St. David Irrigation District. Gail and Renita Larson and Beverly and Thomas Wing were listed as members who joined the St. David Irrigation District. Robert and Sherrie Bernal, Marie and Nolan Larson, and Philip Earl Larson were not included on either list and they did not appear at the status conference.

By order dated October 5, 2018, the cases previously consolidated into a single case known as *In re Pomerene Water Users Association* were separated into individual cases. As a result, the potential water rights analyzed in the WFR will be considered in this separate case or will be consolidated with *In re St. David Irrigation*, contested case no. W1-11-1675 as appropriate.

Landowners

The first step to adjudicate the water rights identified by the WFR is to identify the current landowners involved in this case. Based on the WFR, the land involved may include the following tax parcels: 12327001K, 12327001M, 12327001N, 12327001P, 12327001Q and

Canal. The WFR lists Statements of Claimant 39-6619 and 39-6620 as the applicable adjudication filings. Thurber E. Larson filed the Statements of Claimant. The Arizona Department of Water Resources public records do not include any assignments of the Statements of Claimant. The purpose of this case is to resolve the five objections to the proposed water right listed in the WFR to the extent that the current landowners intend to pursue it.

Until October 5, 2018, this case was consolidated and a part of that group of cases known as *In re Pomerene Water Users Association*, contested case no. W1-11-1676. In that case, the court scheduled a status conference for June 28, 2017 in part to identify the proper parties. At the status conference, counsel for the Pomerene Water Users Association was given until October 2, 2017 to provide documentation concerning the continuing authority of Pomerene Water Users Association to act. No landowners appeared at the status conference.

By order dated July 26, 2017, the court directed the owners of land for which Arizona Department of Water Resources had identified as places of use for water diverted through the Pomerene Canal to file new or amended statements of claimant if they desired to assert a claim for a right to divert water through the Pomerene Canal for irrigation use. A second status conference was set for October 18, 2017. The public records of Arizona Department of Water Resources do not contain a statement of claimant filed by any of the above-named individuals.

At the status conference held on October 18, 2017, the newly elected board of the Pomerene Water Users Association appeared along with its counsel. The court directed the Pomerene Water Users Association to file a list by December 29, 2017 that identified those landowners who were members by the Pomerene Water Users Association and whose


