This case involves *de minimis* claims for water rights analyzed by Watershed File Reports 111-20-032, 111-23-AAA-001, 111-24-CCB-011 and 112-17-063, included in the final hydrographic survey report for the San Pedro Watershed (“San Pedro HSR”) filed on November 20, 1991. In 1994, the Special Master issued a Memorandum Decision, Findings of Fact, and

1 Conclusions of Law for Group 1 Cases involving Stockwatering, Stockponds, and Domestic Uses,  
2 dated November 14, 1994, amended February 23, 1995, approved and modified September 27,  
3 2002 (“Decision”). The Decision established the procedures for adjudicating *de minimis* water  
4 rights for claims in the San Pedro watershed.

5 After the proposed water right abstracts have been prepared, “the litigants will be provided  
6 an opportunity to suggest the correction of mistakes in the proposed abstracts.” Decision, p. 47.  
7 Once the clerical corrections have been completed, the abstracts will be included in a catalog of  
8 proposed water rights where they will be subject to very limited set of objections and, ultimately  
9 in a final decree. As required by the Decision, proposed water right abstracts have been prepared  
10 for the *de minimis* water rights analyzed by Watershed File Reports 111-20-032, 111-23-AAA-  
11 001, 111-24-CCB-011 and 112-17-063, which are attached as Appendix A.

12 **IT IS ORDERED** that any suggested corrections to the proposed abstracts shall be filed  
13 on or before **January 27, 2023**. If the United States proposes any corrections to the legal  
14 descriptions, the proposed corrections shall be accompanied by a map showing the location of the  
15 potential water use and point of diversion.
