This contested case was initiated on April 1, 2024, to adjudicate claims associated with Watershed File Report (“WFR”) No. 114-04-BAC-019. During the April 25, 2024, initial status conference, there was confusion among the parties regarding parcel boundaries and ownership since the original parcel appears to have been subdivided. The Minute Entry for the April 25, 2024, conference, filed May 1, 2024, instructed ADWR to provide an updated map of the WFR, with current parcel boundaries, by May 24, 2024.

On May 23, 2024, ADWR filed a revised map for WFR No. 114-04-BAB-019. The Court is unaware of any WFR or well report with that number. It appears, based upon the


1 contents of the map and associated report, the map actually depicts the land investigated as
2 part of WFR No. 114-04-BAB-119, which is associated with contested case No. W1-11-
3 3113.

5 **THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** that ADWR will submit a new map depicting
6 the parcels investigated as part of **WFR No. 114-04-BAC-019** to the Court by **July 8, 2024**.
