
As the General Adjudication has grown, so has the amount of time, effort, and cost associated with distributing Court documents. To reduce the effort as well as to provide quicker, more cost-effective service of Court documents, the Clerk of Court has

1 implemented a process whereby parties can receive Court documents via email, rather
2 than hard copy via the postal service. Many parties who appear in this case have already
3 taken advantage of this service, but there are many who have not. Accordingly,

4 **IT IS ORDERED** that all attorneys who currently appear in case W-1, W-2, W-
5 3, W-4 as part of the General Adjudication sign up for this electronic service of Court
6 documents by **August 1, 2024**. Attorneys who appear before the General Adjudication
7 after August 1, 2024, must sign up for the electronic service of Court documents within
8 five (5) business days of a filing a notice of appearance or receiving an approval of a
9 motion for substitution. The form to sign up is attached as Attachment A

10 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that in an effort to mirror the requirements of
11 other divisions, as well as prevent potential problems when the General Adjudication is
12 eventually included with the other electronic communications of the Clerk, if multiple
13 attorneys from the same law firm appear, irrespective of whether they are involved in
14 different contested cases or represent different clients, a single email address shall be
15 used to receive these Court documents by all attorneys from that firm.
