HB 3319: INFORMATION RELATING TO MOVE OVER OR SLOW DOWN STATEMENT OF ASSURANCE

Effective September 1, 2021, <u>House Bill 3319</u>, from the 87th Legislative Session requires that Driver Education and Driving Safety (DES) curriculum include "Information Relating to Passing Certain Vehicles". This information shall include that the requirements of <u>Section 545.157</u>, <u>Transportation Code</u>, concerning the passing of certain vehicles be included in the curriculum of each driver education course or driving safety course.

No later than September 1, 2022, each driver education school, parent taught course provider, and driving safety course provider is required to:

- 1. Update their curriculum; and
- 2. Complete and submit this Statement of Assurance form.

Bill Placement Information: When updating your curriculum, H.B. 3319 must be included in the topics and modules for the courses listed below as found in the Program Guides.

- Driver Education: Module One (POI-DE)
- Adult 6-hour: Chapter Four, Topic Three (POI-Adult 6-Hour)
- 6-Hour Driving Safety: Chapter Four, Topic Four (COI-DS)
- Specialized Driving Safety: Chapter Four, Topic Three (COI-SDS)
