SB 1831: INFORMATION RELATING TO HUMAN TRAFFICKING STATEMENT OF ASSURANCE

Effective September 1, 2022, [Senate Bill 1831 \(also known as the Julia Wells Act\)](#), from the 87th Legislative Session requires that driver education and driving safety curriculum include “Information Relating to Human Trafficking Prevention”.

No later than September 1, 2022, each driver education school, parent taught course provider, and driving safety course provider is required to:

1. Update their curriculum; and
2. Complete and submit this Statement of Assurance form.

This information shall include at a minimum:

- activities commonly associated with human trafficking
- recognition of potential victims of human trafficking, and
- methods for assisting victims of human trafficking, including how to report human trafficking.
