INTRODUCTION

This publication provides labor force estimates and nonfarm employment estimates for the years 2013 through 2017. It includes data for the state, Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs), and non-MSA counties.

Statewide annual average labor force estimates are adjusted to the Current Population Survey (CPS), a monthly survey of 60,000 occupied U.S. households conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau for the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. Estimates for the state have been adjusted to the 2017 benchmark for the five years covered in this publication. MSA and non-MSA county estimates have been adjusted to the most current benchmark revision for each year.

Nonfarm employment by industry is produced from a survey of employers, providing an estimate of jobs by place of work. The data includes all full-time and part-time nonfarm wage and salary employees who worked during, or received pay for, the payroll period which includes the 12th day of the month. Estimates of employment for the state, MSAs, and non-MSA counties have been adjusted to the most current benchmark revision for each of the years.
